STATE ROUTE 65 REDUCED TO ONE LANE NEXT WEEK IN TULARE COUNTY

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in cooperation with Chester Bross Construction Company will reduce State Route 65 to one lane in each direction with alternating lane closures between Porterville and Lindsay in Tulare County as part of a paving rehabilitation project.

The following lane closures will be in effect next week:

Northbound State Route 65 will be reduced to one lane between Porterville and Lindsay in Tulare County beginning Monday, September 29th thru Friday, October 3rd, 2014 from 6:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. each day.

State Route 65 will be reduced to one lane in this area during work hours. Motorists can expect delays and are encouraged to take an alternate route if possible. Closures may continue for longer periods of time if necessary, due to delays caused by uncontrollable events that may occur during road construction procedures.

Reckless or inattentive drivers traveling through Work Zone Areas have caused the majority of Work Zone Deaths. Caltrans wants to remind drivers to stay attentive and undistracted while driving and to be cognizant of workers and vehicles in Construction and Maintenance Areas and slow down while driving through Work Zones. **Be Work Zone Alert.**
