MOVING LANE CLOSURES FOR STATE ROUTE 99 SCHEDULED FOR TOMORROW

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in cooperation with Papich Construction, Inc. announces moving lane closures on northbound and southbound State Route 99 in Goshen, within Tulare County. These closures are part of the current State Route 99 Tulare to Goshen-North Segment Widening Project and are necessary for roadway striping operations.

Scheduled moving lane closures will be as follows:

Northbound State Route 99 between the State Route 198 interchange and Betty Drive in Goshen will be reduced to one lane with alternating lane changes tomorrow Thursday, December 18th between 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Southbound State Route 99 between the State Route 198 interchange and Betty Drive in Goshen will be reduced to one lane with alternating lane changes tomorrow Thursday, December 18th between 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

These closures may include various on and off ramps between State Route 198 and Betty Drive at various times to allow crews to work within the project area.

Closures may continue for longer periods of time if necessary, due to delays caused by weather or uncontrollable events that may occur during construction. Motorists may experience delays and are encouraged to take alternate routes whenever possible.
