## CALTRANS ANNOUNCES PAVEMENT REPAIR OPERATIONS ALONG STATE ROUTE 99 IN FRESNO COUNTY

**WHAT:** CONCRETE GRINDING AND PAVING PROJECT ALONG NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 99.

**WHEN:** BEGINS SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 28<sup>TH</sup> AT 7:00 P.M.

**WHERE:** FRESNO COUNTY; ALONG NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND SR 99 BETWEEN THE STATE ROUTE 99/201 OVERCROSSING IN KINGSBURG AND THE MOUNTAIN VIEW OVERCROSSING SOUTH OF THE CITY OF SELMA.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces *Granite Construction* will conduct concrete grinding and concrete slab replacements within various locations within the project limits along State Route 99. Beginning Sunday evening, September 28<sup>th</sup> the **southbound (SB) # 3** (closest to the right shoulder) lane of State Route (SR) 99 will be subject to lane closure operations in order to implement this highway improvement project.

**The following schedule for each direction of travel within the #3 lane will be in place in order to safely complete this project:**

- **Southbound:** Sunday, September 28<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. continuous until Friday, October 3<sup>rd</sup> at Noon.
- **Northbound:** Sunday, October 12<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. continuous until Friday, October 17<sup>th</sup> at Noon.

**(Schedule or specific lane closures are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances which may occur during construction operations.)**

Motorists may experience traffic delays along State Route 99 during this time as only two lanes of travel will be accessible to motorists within the work zone. It is anticipated that on and off-ramps located within the project limits will remain open. Motorists are encouraged to avoid the area or use an alternate route whenever possible in order to avoid possible delays.

Portable changeable message signs (PCMS) will be activated within the project limits notifying motorists of lane closures due to construction. Caltrans would like to thank motorists for their patience during this pavement repair project. The public is reminded to be alert for contractor and Caltrans personnel and to merge when directed to do so. For further information regarding this project, please contact the number listed above.
