CALTRANS ANNOUNCES FULL CLOSURE FOR PAVEMENT REPAIRS

WHAT: Full closure and detour of Northbound State Route (SR) 99 traffic for Cottonwood Creek bridge pavement repairs.

WHEN: [NORTHBOUND DETOUR- BEGINS NEXT WEEK, WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 19TH 11:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m. the following morning.](#)

WHERE: Madera County; northbound SR 99 closure between Avenue 9 (Exit 147) and Avenue 12 (Exit 151).

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces that traffic along State Route (SR) 99 will be diverted off of State Route 99 at the Avenue 9 interchange in order for **Contractor, Don Berry Construction Inc.** to safely implement pavement repairs on both sides of the Cottonwood Creek Bridge located just south of Avenue 12 in Madera County. It is anticipated that repairs will be completed in one night. Advance signage will be in place and motorists are advised to use an alternate route or add additional time to their commute. Schedule is subject to change due to any unforeseen circumstances that may occur before/during construction; full freeway closures may be completed earlier than anticipated based on contractor operations. The California Highway Patrol (CHP) will be present to provide extra support for traffic control for the following detour beginning August, 19th, at 11:00 p.m.

NORTHBOUND SR 99 TRAFFIC TO EXIT AT AVE 9 OFF-RAMP; TURN RIGHT; TURN LEFT ONTO ROAD 30 ½ TO AVE 12; TURN LEFT; CONTINUE TO NB 99 AVE 12 TO ACCESS NB 99 ON-RAMP.
