CITY OF FRESNO IMPROVEMENT PROJECT REQUIRES EXTENDED ON-RAMP CLOSURE

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans), City, County, Moorefield Construction, Inc. and Provost & Pritchard Consulting Group announce an upcoming scheduled long-term closure of the southbound (SB) State Route (SR) 99 Grantland/Parkway Avenue on-ramp located within the City of Fresno as part of the on-going ***State Route 99 Herndon Avenue Interchange Improvement Project***. This ramp closure is necessary to allow crews to safely continue current construction operations at/near this location.

The following southbound on-ramp will be closed for a period of 31 days beginning Sunday, January 5th, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. through Wednesday, February 5th, 2014; at 6:00 a.m.

- **Southbound State Route 99 On-Ramp from Grantland/Parkway Avenue**

Suggested Detour:

Access Golden State Blvd. via Herndon Avenue; turn right; continue southbound on Golden State Blvd. to Shaw Avenue; turn right; continue along Shaw Avenue to access the southbound SR99 on-ramp.

Scheduled closures dates and times are subject to change due to delays caused by unforeseen weather conditions, or uncontrollable events which may occur during construction.

Caltrans would like to thank the residents, businesses and commuters for their continued patience during this improvement project. Please adhere to all posted signage and watch for construction workers and equipment at all times. Please drive with extra care while traveling through construction work zones, and please **“Slow for the Cone Zone at all times”**.
