CALTRANS ANNOUNCES SHOULDER WORK ALONG STATE ROUTE 99 IN FRESNO COUNTY

WHAT: SHOULDER WORK OPERATIONS ALONG NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 99 REQUIRES LANE AND SHOULDER CLOSURES.

WHEN: TUESDAY, MAY 5TH - FRIDAY, MAY 8TH (SOUTHBOUND)
MONDAY, MAY 11TH -THURSDAY, MAY 14TH (NORTHBOUND)

WHERE: FRESNO COUNTY; ALONG NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND SR 99; CLOSURE OF THE #3 (SLOW) LANE AND SHOULDERS BETWEEN SECOND STREET (SELMA) AND BETHEL AVENUE.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces Caltrans maintenance staff will conduct shoulder paving that will result in the closure of the **southbound (SB) #3 (slow)** lane and shoulder of State Route (SR) 99 beginning tomorrow morning at 9:00 a.m. Maintenance within the northbound lanes will occur the following week within the project limits. **(Schedule or specific closures are subject to change or cancellation due unforeseen circumstances that may occur during maintenance operations.)**

Maintenance operations are scheduled to occur as follows:

- **Southbound State Route 99:** Tuesday, May 5th – Thursday, May 7th 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.
Southbound State Route 99: Friday, May 8th 9:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m.
- **Northbound State Route 99:** Monday, May 11th –Thursday, May 14th, 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.

(At no time will both directions of travel lanes be closed at the same time.)

Motorists may experience traffic delays along SR 99 during this time as travel lanes will be reduced to two lanes. It is anticipated that on and off-ramps within the work zone will remain open. Motorists are encouraged to avoid this area or use an alternate route whenever possible in order to avoid possible delays.

Portable changeable message signs (CMS) will be activated prior to the closures in order to notify motorists of lane closures and to expect delays within the project limits. Motorists are expected to obey traffic laws and merge when directed to do so.

Caltrans reminds motorists that the safety of our motorists' and work crew personnel is most important, therefore, please stay alert and "**Be Work Zone Alert**" in all maintenance zones at all times.
