NORTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 99 LANE CLOSURE DUE TO GUARDRAIL REPAIRS

WHAT: NORTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 99 MEDIAN AND #1 LANE CLOSURE

WHEN: THIS SUNDAY, MARCH 15TH, FROM 7:00 A.M. UNTIL 3:00 P.M.

WHERE: FRESNO COUNTY; NORTHBOUND (NB) STATE ROUTE 99 FROM CLOVIS AVENUE TO NORTH AVENUE.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces maintenance crews will conduct damaged guardrail repair operations this weekend, Sunday, March 15th from 7:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. in order to minimize traffic impacts to motorists during the work week.

Maintenance operations will occur within the median of northbound SR99; therefore, the median and the #1 (fast) lane will be closed to motorists within the project limits.

Signage will be in place notifying motorists of upcoming lane and shoulder closures. Motorists are advised that closures may continue for longer periods of time due to delays caused by weather or uncontrollable events that may occur during maintenance. Closure schedule is also subject to change due to possible early completion of necessary repairs.

Caltrans would like to thank the local residents, businesses and commuters for their patience during these closures and reminds you to drive with extra care. Please be work zone alert and watch for highway workers, adhere to posted signage, merge when directed and please remember to **“Don’t Trash Fresno,”** take pride in your community; do your part to eliminate trash and debris on our local streets and highways.
