PUMP STATION MAINTENANCE OPERATIONS BEGIN SATURDAY IN MADERA COUNTY

WHAT: MAINTENANCE OF PUMP STATION LOCATED ALONG STATE ROUTE 99
WHEN: SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 7TH, 6:00 A.M. UNTIL NOON
WHERE: CITY OF MADERA; SOUTHBOUND STATE ROUTE (SR) 99 JUST SOUTH OF CLEVELAND AVENUE OVERCROSSING.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces that maintenance personnel will implement maintenance operations of a pump station located just south of the Cleveland Avenue overcrossing on SATURDAY, February 7th instead of Sunday, February 8th as previously announced.

In order to safely implement these operations, a lane closure of the #2 lane and shoulder area within the project limits will be in place; the California Highway Patrol (CHP) will also be on site to provide extra support for traffic control. Initial set-up operations will begin at 6:00 a.m. or approximately one hour before the full lane and shoulder closure along southbound SR 99. It is anticipated that traffic impacts may result from these closures; however, delays are expected to be minimal.

Motorists are advised to adhere to closure signage and to merge when directed to do so. Please watch for Caltrans equipment and personnel working in the area. Caltrans reminds drivers to be **“Work Zone Alert”** through all maintenance and construction projects and to **“Slow for the Cone Zone.”**

This schedule is subject to change due to rain, fog delays or early completion of operation efforts. Caltrans would like to thank the residents, businesses and commuters for their patience during this maintenance improvement project.
