CALTRANS ADVISES LANE CLOSURE DUE TO MAINTENANCE

WHAT: SLAB REPAIR PROJECT ALONG SOUTHBOUND 99 REQUIRES LANE CLOSURE.

WHEN: THIS WEEK, FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 27TH, 9:00 A.M. UNTIL 2:00 P.M.

WHERE: FRESNO COUNTY; SOUTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 99 FROM McCALL AVENUE TO MOUNTAIN VIEW AVENUE.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces maintenance personnel will conduct slab repair operations within the **Southbound (SB)** number three (slow) lane of State Route (SR) 99 Friday morning beginning at 9:00 a.m. In order to safely complete this project, the right shoulder within the project limits will also be closed to motorists. **(Schedule or specific lane closures are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances which may occur during maintenance operations.)**

Traffic delays may occur along southbound SR99 during this time and it is anticipated that on and off-ramps within the project limits will remain open. Motorists are encouraged to avoid the area or use an alternate route whenever possible.

Portable changeable message signs (PCMS) will be activated north of the project limits notifying motorists of lane closure in order for motorists to merge accordingly.

Caltrans would like to thank motorists for their patience during this improvement project. The public is reminded to be alert for Caltrans personnel and to merge when directed to do so. The safety of our motorists' and work crew personnel is most important, therefore, please stay work zone alert and "**Slow for the Cone Zone**" in all Construction and Maintenance Zones at all times.
