CLOSURES TOMORROW EVENING IN SELMA

WHAT: SLAB REPAIR PROJECT ALONG NORTHBOUND STATE ROUTE (SR) 99 REQUIRES LANE AND ON/OFF RAMP CLOSURES.

WHEN: TOMORROW NIGHT, THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 24TH 9:00 P.M. UNTIL 5:00 A.M. FRIDAY MORNING, SEPTEMBER 25TH.

WHERE: CITY OF SELMA; NORTHBOUND SR 99 FROM SECOND STREET TO FLORAL AVENUE.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces maintenance personnel will conduct concrete slab repair operations within the **northbound (NB)** number #2 (middle) and #3 (slow) lanes of SR 99 tomorrow evening beginning at 9:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m. the following morning. In order to safely complete this project, on and off-ramp located within the project limits will also be closed to motorists. **(Schedule or specific lane closures are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances which may occur during maintenance operations.)**

The following on/off ramps will be closed during this maintenance project:

- Second Street On-Ramp to NB 99
- Floral Avenue On/Off Ramps to NB 99
- NB 99 Off-Ramp to Floral Avenue

Traffic delays may occur along northbound SR99 during this time as only the #1 lane (fast) will remain open. Motorists are encouraged to avoid the area or use an alternate route whenever possible. The California Highway Patrol (CHP) will/may be present to provide additional traffic support.

Portable changeable message signs (PCMS) will be activated south of the project limits notifying motorists of lane closures in order for motorists to merge accordingly.

Caltrans would like to thank motorists for their patience during this improvement project. The public is reminded to be alert for Caltrans personnel and to merge when directed to do so. The safety of our motorists' and work crew personnel is most important, therefore, please stay work zone alert and "**Slow for the Cone Zone**" in all Construction and Maintenance Zones at all times.
