## NIGHT LANE AND RAMP CLOSURES FOR STATE ROUTE 99 THIS WEEK IN TULARE COUNTY

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in association with **Papich Construction, Inc.** announces continued lane and ramp closures this week on northbound and southbound State Route 99 in Goshen, within Tulare County. These closures are part of ongoing construction for the State Route 99 Tulare to Goshen-North Segment Widening Project.

**Scheduled lane and ramp closures will be as follows, weather permitting:**

- **Northbound and southbound State Route 99, between the State Route 198 interchange and just north of Betty Drive in Goshen, will be reduced to one lane with alternating ramp closures from Sunday, October 4<sup>th</sup> to Friday, October 9<sup>th</sup> between the hours of 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m. the following morning.**

These closures will include various on and off ramps between State Route 198 and Betty Drive at various times to allow crews to work with the project area.

Closures may continue for longer periods of time if necessary, due to delays caused by weather or uncontrollable events that may occur during construction. Motorists are encouraged to avoid this area during project work hours and use alternate routes if possible.

Caltrans would like to remind drivers to please be alert for road construction personnel and be work zone alert; and remember **“Slow for the Cone Zone.”**
