RAMP CLOSURES SCHEDULED ON STATE ROUTE 99 IN BAKERSFIELD AREA

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces scheduled ramp closures at Olive Drive, Houghton Road and Herring Road at State Route 99, within the Bakersfield city limits, in Kern County. These closures will be necessary to allow Maintenance crews to conduct asphalt maintenance operations on the ramps.

The following closures are scheduled between Sunday, April 29th and May 2nd, 2012 (weather permitting):

Sunday, April 29th, 2012:

Southbound State Route 99 on-ramps from eastbound and westbound Olive Drive, will be closed between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

Tuesday, May 1st, 2012:

Southbound and northbound State Route 99 on-ramps and off-ramps from eastbound and westbound Houghton Road, will be closed between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

Wednesday, May 2nd, 2012:

Southbound and northbound State Route 99 on-ramps and off-ramps from eastbound and westbound Herring Road, will be closed between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

These scheduled closures will occur, weather permitting. Closures may continue for longer periods of time if necessary, due to delays caused by weather or uncontrollable events that may occur during maintenance.

Caltrans Maintenance workers would like to thank the local residents, businesses and commuters for their patience and remind you to drive with extra care and allow additional travel time while travelling on State Route 99.
