

State Route 145 Kerman Rehabilitation

Fresno · Madera · Kings · Tulare · Kern

Fresno County

Project Purpose:

The purpose of this project is to extend and preserve the life of pavement from just south of California Avenue to the State Route 180 Junction. This 1-mile segment of State Route 145 will be improved by removing and replacing the existing pavement and providing a new improved route.

State Route 145, within the project limits, is a four-lane divided highway serving as the main thoroughfare through the City of Kerman. This project will provide a much smoother driving surface, thus improving mobility and enhancing safety along this portion of highway.

Description:

This project will consist of cold planing the existing asphalt concrete pavement, repair sub-surface damage and asphalt overlay the cold planed pavement.
