

State Route 41 Herndon Auxillary Lane

Fresno · Madera · Kings · Tulare · Kern

Fresno County

Project Purpose:

The purpose of this project is to improve the operation of northbound State Route 41 by reducing congestion and improving vehicle traffic flow between Bullard Avenue and the northbound Herndon Avenue off-ramp located within the city of Fresno.

State Route 41, within the project limits, is a six-lane divided freeway. This project will improve the quality of traffic flow, reduce congestion, and improve safety along this portion of northbound State Route 41 by expanding the capacity of the previous existing facility.

Description:

This project will widen the Herndon Avenue Northbound off-ramp and construct an auxiliary lane on northbound State Route 41 from the Bullard Avenue on-ramp to the northbound Herndon Avenue off-ramp.
