

State Route 41 Northbound Ramp Meters

Fresno · Madera · Kings · Tulare · Kern

Fresno County

Project Purpose:

The primary purpose of this project is to reduce recurrent congestion and overall travel time of the total traffic stream on freeway State Route 41 and surrounding surface streets.

State Route 41, within the project limits, is a six-lane divided freeway with various on and off-ramps. This project will improve the quality of traffic flow, reduce congestion and improve safety along northbound State Route 41 by improving the flow of traffic entering northbound State Route 41.

Description:

This improvement project located in Fresno county from Ashlan Avenue to just north of Bullard Avenue will take place along northbound State Route 41. Four ramp metering systems will be installed along State Route 41 at various locations. Improvements will take place at the Ashlan Avenue, Shaw Avenue, and Bullard Avenue on-ramps.
