


# District 6 Fact Sheet



## State Route 99 North Fresno Six-Lane

Fresno · Madera · Kings · Tulare · Kern

Fresno County

### Project Purpose:

The purpose of this project is to improve the operational characteristics of a 3.9-mile segment of State Route 99 from just north of the Ashlan Avenue overcrossing to just north of the Herndon/Grantland Avenue undercrossing within the City of Fresno. Constructing one additional lane in each direction will expand the capacity, reduce congestion and delay while enhancing safety.

### Description:

This project will widen the existing four-lane freeway to a six-lane freeway. Roadway and structure widening will occur within the median. No additional right of way is required. Any lane closures required for construction will occur in the overnight hours.

### Project Construction Cost:

\$17 Million

Begin Date: Fall 2010


