## CALTRANS ANNOUNCES RIBBON CUTTING CEREMONY

**WHO:** The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) celebrates the completion of the *State Route 99 San Joaquin River Six-Lane* widening project which began in 2013. This newest segment along State Route 99 now provides three lanes in each direction of travel within Fresno County.

**WHAT:** Ribbon Cutting Ceremony for this improvement project incorporates both Fresno and Madera Counties. Two additional lanes have been constructed within the median and the San Joaquin River bridges have been replaced to increase highway capacity, improve safety and reduce traffic congestion.

**WHEN:** Friday, May 29<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 a.m. (See Map)

**WHERE:** West of State Route 99; just south of the San Joaquin River Bridge near contractors yard.



### Driving Directions from State Route 99



**Southbound SR99:** Exit Herndon Avenue off-ramp. Turn right at signal onto Herndon Ave. under SR99 overcrossing; make a right turn onto N. Parkway Avenue. Follow road to event site and parking.

**Northbound SR99:** Exit Herndon Avenue off-ramp, turn left at signal. Go under SR99 overcrossing; make a right turn onto N. Parkway Avenue. Follow road to event site and parking.
