


## PEAR GIS NAVIGATION WIDGET



### FULL EXTENT TOOL

The Full Extent Tool lets you view the entire selected area, to its full extent.

### SLIDING ZOOM IN/ OUT TOOL

The Zoom In/ Out Tool lets you view an area in detail.

### PANNING TOOL

The Panning Tool lets you zoom in and out using the + and – icons. The hand icon lets you pan the chosen area in the direction you want.

## The Full Extent Tool

The Full Extent Tool lets you view the entire selected area and any projects or selected projects in the chosen district.

### GLOBE ICON

When clicking on the globe icon, you will see the entire district, as well as any chosen project(s) in the selected area.

### PANNING ARROW ICONS

When clicking on the arrow icons, you will pan to the selected direction on the map, not necessarily in the selected area.


### FULL EXTENT ARROW ICONS

When zoomed in onto a selected area or project on the map, it will take you to the next and previous extent.




## Sliding Zoom In/ Out Tool

The Sliding Zoom In/ Out Tool lets you zoom in and out of the map. When using the slider, you will also get coordinates to the area you are zooming in and out of.



## Panning Tool

The Panning Tool lets you zoom in and out using the + and - icons. Click on either icon and select an area on the map you want to zoom in/ out of. The Hand icon lets you grab an area on the map and move it around.



## How to Use the Plus and Minus Icons


1. First click on the + or – icon.



The selected icon is highlighted with a light blue box around it.

2. A cross cursor will then appear on your screen.

The cursor has a cross and is ready to select the area to zoom in or out of.



3. Once ready, place the cursor where you want the beginning point to be, and left click + hold as you draw a square around the selected area.



The selected area will be zoomed in or zoomed out of, depending which icon was selected.

The cross icon is displayed when using the panning icons to zoom in/ out.

- Once desired area is selected, let go of the mouse, and you will zoom in/ out of the selected area.

Selected area has been zoomed in by using the + sign.
