


ELEVATION PROFILE


The purpose of the tutorial is to showcase the functionality of the **Elevation Profile** tool. The *Elevation Profile* tool is used to measure the elevation of a location on the map.

1. The *Elevation* tool is found in the *Map Tools* menu folder, at the bottom of the screen.




The *Elevation Profile* tool is located in the *Map Tools* menu folder at the bottom of the screen.


2. When selecting the *Elevation Profile* tool, a window appears and is ready to measure the elevation in the desired location.



3. First select the measurement units you want your results to return.



4. Next, click on the map to place the points and measure the desired area. Multiple points can be placed on the map, just double click on the last point when done placing points on the map.



5. The results will then appear in the *Profile Result* tab. Click *Clear* to reset and start anew.
