


## GOOGLE STREET VIEW


The purpose of the tutorial is to showcase the functionality of the **Google Street View** tool. The *Street View* tool is used to display the street view of a location on the map.

1. The *Street View* tool is found in the *Map Tools* menu folder, at the bottom of the screen.




The *Google Street View* tool is located in the *Map Tools* menu folder at the bottom of the screen.


2. First, zoom to the area on the map you want to view.
3. Select the *Street View* tool and click on the *Google Street View* person to place anywhere on the map.



- Once it is placed on the map, a pop up window appears with the street view of that location.



- The street view can be changed by maneuvering in the direction desired within the window. Just hover, click and drag in the desired direction.



- To relocate the *Street View man*, click and drag the icon to a different location on the map.
