


SEARCH TOOL


The purpose of the tutorial is to showcase the functionality of the Search Tool.

Search Tool is used to perform graphical and spatial search on the map. It allows you to graphically select defined map features by clicking on the map using different tools. Additionally you can do a text search for defined map features by name.

1. To find the **Search** tool, click on the **GIS Tools** folder icon, and select **Search**.





2. Once you click on the Search tool, a window opens with several options.




3. To minimize, click on the minimize icon. To reopen application, click on the icon to reopen window.




4. To use the Search tool, select a layer you want to search for, then select the drawing tool you want to use.




5. Select an area of the map, and click and hold to use the shape drawing tools, draw your lines by placing your dots on the map, or placing a point in the desired location to search.



6. The results for the selected layer within the search area displayed on the map, along with the information in the Search tool window.



7. To reset your search, click on the **Select Features** icon on the upper right corner of the window.



NOTE: The **Select Features** icon lets you search for other features on the map, but it does not clear your previous search. To clear your previous search, click on the **Clear** link.

8. The Results icon, on the upper right corner, lets you view your results. If you navigated away from the results, click on the Results icon to view current results.



Select the **Results** icon to view current search results.
