CONSTRUCTION ON STATE HIGHWAY IN TEHAMA COUNTY NEAR CORNING AT CORNING SAFETY ROADSIDE REST AREAS RECONSTRUCT AND REHABILITATE BUILDINGS, LANDSCAPE AND PARKING LOT.

On July 3, 2015, you were notified that bids for this contract were rejected due in part to an error that occurred during the creation of the bid documents, specifically the electronic bid book. As a result, the bids submitted did not include the following required certifications:

- Certification of "Small Business"
- Federal-Aid Projects Disclosure of Lobbying Activities
- Disclosure of Lobbying Activities Pursuant to 31 U.S.C.1352 (form)
- Equal Employment Opportunity Regulation
- Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 29, Debarment and Suspension

While the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) considers the aforementioned certifications to be material, Caltrans has reconsidered its position regarding bid rejection for failure to include said certifications due to the fact that the error occurred during the creation of the electronic bid book and was not based on bidder error. Caltrans is rescinding the rejection of all bids and agrees to consider the bid submittals, provided that the bidder submits the certifications mentioned above and attached hereto.

Bidders must acknowledge and return the certifications to Caltrans by 4:00 pm on July 20, 2015. Failure to do so will render the bid nonresponsive.
