

 Per Diem: \$ 105.00 per diem (Per Nightly Lodging if necessary)
 Weekend Hold: \$ 80.00 per hour with a 6 hour minimum (Per day lodging onsite during weekend)
 Cancellation: \$ 95.00 per hour with a 6 hour minimum (Per scheduled day canceled)
 Weekend Rate: \$ 15.00 per hour additional (Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays)
 Night Rate: \$ 15.00 per hour (8:00PM – 8:00AM)


