



Natural Investigations is a California certified Woman Business Enterprise (WBE), Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE), and Small Business Enterprise (SBE) in biological resources, cultural/archaeological resources, and environmental consulting/permitting. Our company is unique in its ability to find creative solutions to the environmental needs and challenges facing its clients, at the same time understanding the ultimate goal of any project is to assist clients in successfully meeting the technical requirements while adhering to schedule and budget constraints.

Natural Investigations is please to submit our scope for the Biological Information Program (Item #6, Item code 146002) regarding Caltrans Contract #04-2J1504 in Contra Costa County.

Task 1: Preconstruction Survey

Natural Investigations' biologists will submit to the Engineer at least 30-days prior to the start of any job activities protocols for the preconstruction survey. Once the authorization to proceed is given, a biologist will survey all areas of the construction site including work areas, laydown areas, turnaround areas, and trailer/office areas. A preconstruction survey report will be submitted within 14-days prior to the start of construction, documenting the areas surveyed, photographs, dates/time/location of survey, detailed observations and locations where regulated species were observed, or a statement that no regulated species were observed by the biologist.

Task 2: Initial Surveys

Natural Investigations biologist will notify the Engineer 10-days prior to the start of any job activities for an initial nesting bird survey. The Initial Monitoring Report will include areas surveyed, photographs, dates/time/location of survey, detailed observations and locations where regulated species were observed, or a statement that no regulated species were observed by the biologist within 12 hours after starting project activities.

A new nesting birds monitoring survey will be performed every 72 hours and a weekly (every 5 working days) monitoring report will be submitted. The report will include areas surveyed, photographs, dates/time/location of survey, detailed observations and locations where regulated species were observed, or a statement that no regulated species were observed the biologist. Monitor for regulated species within the project area. Monitoring duties will include, assure that construction activities do not result in take of regulated species, assure that construction activities comply with PLACs, immediately notify the Engineer of any take of regulated species, and prepare, submit, and sign notifications and reports.

Note: For the purposes of this scope and cost estimate, Natural Investigations assumes that the nesting bird survey/monitoring will be negative and that no Incident Report will be warranted. Additionally, Natural Investigations assumes that monitoring days will not exceed a total of 55-survey events. The following is a breakdown of survey events: Route 4: 10 survey events, Route I-80: 16 survey events, Route I-580: 10 survey events, I-680, 19 survey events. A survey event is defined as 4 hours for a biologist to drive and survey a specific work area locations.

Task 3: Final Monitoring Report

Natural Investigations biologist will submit the Final Monitoring Report no more than 20-days after completion of project. The Final Monitoring Report will include construction beginning and ending dates, identification of project impacts on the species covered in the plan, species protection measures with protection measure implementation details, incidental take details, including species name, number taken, people contacted, contact information, and disposition of taken species, an assessment of the effectiveness of the species protection measures to mitigate project impacts, and recommendations to improve efficiency of protection measures to mitigate impacts to regulated species.


