Irene,

This contract sought DBE participation, not DVBE participation. We have noted in Murphy Industrial Coatings' bid documents that Murphy listed Global Environmental Network for four bid items, and Cal-Vet Services for two bid items. Both these companies are DVBE, but do not appear to be DBE as they do not show up in a DBE search at the Caltrans DBE website. Qualified DBE firms did submit bids for items 1, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 10 that appear to be competitive with, and in some cases cheaper than quotes that Certified Coatings received from Global Environmental and Cal-Vet Services. We do not believe the intent of the contract documents was met with Murphy's bid, due to items being subcontracted to non-DBE firms that could have been subcontracted to qualified DBE firms. Copies of the quotes Certified Coatings received from Global and Cal-Vet as well as from qualified DBE firms for the subject items are attached.

Additionally, the title of the person signing Murphy's bid is not given. This raises the question whether their signer is the person duly authorized to bind the company under the BidX electronic bidding system.

We believe Murphy's bid is unresponsive to the contract bid documents on at least the first item.
