Dear Mr. Stoloski:

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received a bid from Stoloski & Gonzalez, Inc. (Stoloski) for contract 04-3G7504 on June 24, 2014. Caltrans notifies Stoloski that its bid is nonresponsive because of an incomplete Subcontractor List form.

The Subcontractor List form states in part, "...Complete columns 1 and 4 and submit with the bid. Complete columns 2 and 3 and submit with the bid or fax to (916) 227-6282 within 24 hours after the bid opening. Failure to provide complete information in columns 1 through 4 within the time specified will result in a nonresponsive bid."

On bid day Stoloski provided a description of Subcontracted work to be performed by Lone Star, Landscape, Inc. (Lonestar) as hydroseed, clear and grub, and landscape (bid items 7,9,11,12,13). However; the percentage of actual work to be performed by Lonestar was noted as 0 percent.

The Caltrans Bidder-Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Commitment form states in part..."DBE Subcontractors and their respective item(s) of work listed must be consistent, where applicable, with the names and items of work in the "Subcontractors List" submitted with your bid. Copies of the DBE quotes are required." Stoloski submitted its Commitment form and good faith effort documentation excluding written confirmation or quotes on bid day, and claimed DBE participation for Lonestar in the amount \$14,279.00 for those same items of work and as such, demonstrates that the subcontractor would be performing 100 percent of the work associated with the bid items.

Based on the above, Caltrans has determined that the bid submitted by Stoloski is nonresponsive and will proceed to award this contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, provided that all requirements have been met.

Your attention is directed to Section 3-1.04 of the 2010 Standard Specifications. Caltrans is not obligated to offer an extension of the award period for a nonresponsive bid. Should you wish to extend your bid while resolving a nonresponsive finding, you must send your request to the Office Engineer no later than 4:00 pm, two business days prior to the expiration of your bid.
