



Please note these clarifications and qualifications as a part of this proposal:

- Grade to be received by RMT Landscape at minus 3" from finish grade to allow for sod, free of weeds, debris, and graded to drain. No import or export of soils including lime-treated soil, stockpiling or onsite soils placement. RMT Landscape excludes grading requiring rock or garbage removal, hard rock ripping, dewatering, hazardous, toxic, contaminant removals, or treatment.
- Section 20 (Landscape) mentions various scopes of work that are not included or related to this project. We include only the items noted above and no other items will be included.
- Our proposal is based upon utilizing normal construction related equipment to perform our scope of work. Access to our areas of work is required at all time i.e. unimpeded, no debris, other trades work, vehicles or parked objects and or storage in our way. Our pricing is based upon personnel working during normal (daytime) 8-hour workday, and 40-hour work week and does not include working in an inefficient manner i.e. working in the rain or poor working conditions. Maintenance will begin at completion of our work. Maintenance during entire contact period is not included.
- RMT Landscape's proposal excludes the following items (many items may not apply):
 - Engineering, structural, structural calculations or archeologist, design build including fees, SWPP.
 - Permit fees or costs, i.e. engineering, structural, power or grading, all traffic control including all costs associated, electrical meters and cabinets including meter fees, permits and costs, all irrigation.
 - Water meters, tie in to existing water line, fees, permits and cost of water, potable water line, demolition, roadway excavation, excavation and off haul of soils, including lime treated soil, sleeves or piping through, beneath or under existing or new buildings, utility adjustment, demolition, removal and salvage of existing irrigation and planting, maintenance of existing irrigation, all irrigation (section 20-2), all work related to underground, electrical, all drainage, all fencing (including temporary and wildlife fencing), signage, all drainage including drain piping, excavation and off haul of soils, clear and grub, saw cutting, coring, boring or cutting, patching or removal of asphalt paving or concrete including temporary and permanent patching, rock-wheeling, trench restoration, drilling through slabs or pavers, telephone cable, phone line and hookup.
 - Existing tree, planting, irrigation and turf protection, rodent control, relocation, repair, replacement or pruning of existing landscaping or irrigation including sod, demolition or removal or modification of existing irrigation system including areas outside of limit of work area. Repair or replacement of areas disturbed by construction including replacement of mulch. Replacement of materials by theft or vandalism. Tree and stump removal, pruning. Maintenance and or watering of existing landscaping during construction. Premium time, liquidated damages or bond including maintenance bond.
