Dear Mr. Cerney,

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received a bid submitted by Redwood Engineering Construction (REC) for Contract 04-4A8204 on July 22, 2014. By this letter, Caltrans notifies REC that its bid is nonresponsive because it failed to properly complete the Subcontractor List form.

Caltrans 2010 revised Standard Specifications, Section 2-1.33C states in part, "...*The Subcontractor List must show the name, address, and work portions to be performed by each subcontractor listed. Show work portions by bid item number, description, and percentage of each bid item subcontracted*". Failure to provide complete information in columns 1 through 5 within the time specified will result in a nonresponsive bid." REC failed to submit the bid item numbers and percent of bid item subcontracted for RMT Landscape.

Based on the above, Caltrans will proceed to award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder, providing that all the requirements are met.

Your attention is directed to Section 3-1.04 of the 2010 Standard Specifications. Caltrans is not obligated to offer an extension of the award period for a nonresponsive bid. Should you wish to extend your bid while resolving a nonresponsive finding, you must send your request to the Office Engineer no later than 4:00 p.m., two business days prior to the expiration of your bid.

Bidding Firm Redwood Engineering Construction

Under Public Contract Code § 4100 et seq., the Bidder must set forth in the bid the name, the location of the place of business, the California contractor license number, and the portion of work of each subcontractor who will perform work or labor or render service to the prime contractor in or about the construction of the work or improvement, or a subcontractor licensed by the State of California who, under subcontract to the prime contractor, specially fabricates and installs a portion of the work or improvement according to detailed drawings contained in the plans and specifications, in an amount in excess of one-half of 1 percent of the prime contractor's total bid or ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), whichever is greater.

The Bidder must submit within 24 hours of the bid opening, the bid item numbers with percentages of the portion of work subcontracted.
