

All dump fees (approved w/analyticals) and material purchases are to be paid within 2wks from the date of the invoice if All Counties Trucking's account is used and cannot be discounted (NO EXCEPTIONS)! Weather permitting to enter all desginated dump sites. MUST HAVE ANALYTICAL 2 WEEKS PRIOR TO START OF PROJECT. ANALYTICAL MUST CONTAIN TEST FOR CAM 17, TPH-G, D, M, VOC, SVOC STL'C'S, PESTICIDES/PCB'S & ASBESTOS. CLEAN FILL (MINIMAL DEBRIS), BAY MUD (GAS/VOC ND) MINIMAL DEBRIS <50% MOISTURE, DRY, SPREADABLE, CLASS II DAILY COVER SOIL (GAS/VOC < 50 PPM, MINIMAL DEBRIS) All Strippings MUST be 70% Dirt. A trucking schedule MUST BE PROVIDED 1 to 2 wks prior to start of project. Trucks are subject to schedule & availability and must be mutually agreed upon. Contractor will be responsible for all overload tickets when trucks are loaded by contractor. Contractor will be responsible to provide cleanout area and cleaning solution for asphalt. There will be a 1 hr. min clean out fee for OGAC/RAC/WET BATCH and 30 min. clean out fee for Mud. Neither party shall be liable in damages for strikes, accidents or delays beyond its control. Contractor agrees to pay invoices within 20 days from date of invoice (NO EXCEPTIONS). Please add a 15% increase if a Project Labor Agreement is part of Contract. Cost of fuel today, \$4.102 per gallon. There will be a 2% fuel surcharge in all rates if fuel exceeds \$4.12 per gallon then for every .25 cents increase there will be an additional 2% increase in all rates. Fuel cost based on info. @ eia.doe.gov. Please add a 5% increase every December 31st, beginning 2014. Any loads taken back to plant will be billed at hourly rates.

All off haul is hourly unless otherwise noted. All onsite is hourly. There will be a Stand by charge of 1.80 (\$2.15 for class 1 cal haz) Per Minute for loading and UN-loading pertaining to tonnage and per load rates. Load Site- All trucks after 10 minutes, Security Gate & access gates. CHP, Sally Ports, scales after 5 minutes, Dump Site- Transfers after 15 minutes, all others after 10 minutes. All short days will be billed at hourly rates. Minimum show up time 1 to 2 hours = 4 hours, there will be a six (6) hour minimum for Day and an eight (8) hour minimum for night hauling. Any truck loaded will be billed a 8 hr. min. For high side end dumps there will be an 8 hour min for day and/or night. There will be a 6% mark up on Saturdays and a 12% mark up on Sundays and Holidays and will apply to all tonnage and per load rates unless otherwise noted. All Flat Bed and street sweepers will be billed portal to portal. These rates pertain to any Class II and Class III dumpsites. If applicable bridge tolls and permit fees will be applied to invoice. There will be a 4% increase in all rates if waiver of subrogation needed. This quote is for non prevailing wages unless otherwise noted. If prevailing wages/certified payrolls are required additional rates will be the responsibility of the Contractor and must be paid according to the Davis Bacon Act defined by the DIR and the state of california equipment rental surcharge rates as defined on CADOT web site. If there is a PLA on this project please add an additional 20% to all rates listed above. ALL COUNTIES TRUCKING, INC.
