

- Safety Striping Service, Inc requires an invitation to pre-job meetings.
- Bonds are not included in this quote. If bonds are required, call for rate.
- This quote includes one (1) move-in, defined as a period of consecutive eight hour days of continuous work, not including weekends or holidays. Any deviances from this, other than those initiated by Safety Striping Service, Inc, will be considered additional move-ins and billed at \$3,500.00 each.
- Referencing is included in this quote. Our referencing is LINEAR ONLY, identifying the limits of and changes in the striping details present prior to obliteration. Contractor is required to comply with Section 39-6.01 of the 2006 Standard Specifications (39-1.11 of the 2010 S.S.). Field Layout due to the misplacement of paving seams is at the prime Contractor's expense (Extra Work Force Account). Mobilization for referencing will not be considered a move-in.
- There is no striping / marking / marker removal included in this quote.
- Bid excludes any and all items related to handling hazardous materials including, but not limited to: *removal, testing, containment, hauling and disposal*. If potentially hazardous material (i.e. yellow thermoplastic) is discovered on the job-site, we will stop work until it is determined (in writing) to be non-hazardous, or a change order is issued for proper handling.

15. **Minimum Show-up time: On every truck dispatched to customers project, customer will be responsible for paying at least a 4 hour minimum daytime, & 6 hour minimum nighttime, unless previously arranged with dispatch.**
16. All unscaled tonnage quotes will be based on 25.00 tons per load. All scaled tonnage quotes for partial loads will be based on 24.00 tons. These quotes are based on Santoro Transportation Inc. Performing all trucking requirements on said project.






