Dear Mr. Evans:

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received a bid submitted by Vincent Kentish Evans (VKE) for Contract 05-1F8404 on January 15, 2015. Caltrans notifies VKE that its bid is nonresponsive because it failed to properly submit the Subcontractor List form.

Standard Specifications Section 2-1.33C Subcontractor List states in part... *"The Subcontractor List form must show the name, address, and work portions to be performed by each subcontractor listed. Show work portions by bid item number, description, and percentage of each bid item subcontracted".*

VKE listed on its Subcontractor List form Sapperwest to perform bid item 1 (Lead Compliance Plan) (partial). VKE also listed Super Seal and Stripe to perform bid item 1 (partial) and bid item 3 (Traffic Control System) (partial). Caltrans requires a bidder to submit the exact percentage of all work being performed, not "partial".

In addition, VKE did not list the California contractor's license number for Jernigan Pipeline Supply, which is required on all State funded projects.

Standard Specifications Section 2-1.10 Subcontractor List states in part... *"For each subcontractor listed, the Subcontractor List form must show, (2) For a non-federal-aid contract, its California contractor license number".*

Furthermore, this contract has a 5 percent DVBE goal. On VKE's DVBE Summary it claimed 0.01% DVBE participation. The Office of Business and Economic Opportunity, Contract Evaluation Branch (CEB), determined that VKE did not meet goal and is therefore ineligible for award of this contract.

Standard Specifications Section 2-1.15, Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises, which states in part: *"... Meet the goal shown on the Notice to Bidders".*

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Based on the above, Caltrans finds VKE nonresponsive. Caltrans will proceed to award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder provided all requirements are met.

Your attention is directed to Section 3-1.04 of the 2010 Standard Specifications. Caltrans is not obligated to offer an extension of the award period for a nonresponsive bid. Should you wish to extend your bid while resolving a nonresponsive finding, you must send your request to the Office Engineer no later than 4:00 p.m., two business days prior to the expiration of your bid.
