





- Safety Striping Service, Inc. requires a written subcontract, purchase order or signed quote prior to mobilization for any work, or placing the order for job specific materials (i.e. signs, lead plans, etc).
- Safety Striping Service, Inc requires an invitation to pre-job meetings.

- This quote includes one (1) move-in (unless option is taken; then two (2)), defined as a period of consecutive eight hour days of continuous work, not including weekends or holidays. Field Layout due to the misplacement of paving seams is at the prime Contractor's expense (Extra Work Force Account). Mobilization for referencing will not be considered a move-in.


