

SCOPE OF WORK

SHEET PILE INSTALLATION:

- Install (only) sheet pile as shown on drawings and per project specifications. No Soils Report provided.
 - GC to furnish piles to our pile rig cut in lengths in accordance with the plan profiles, in pairs, welded at the top, with picking-holes ready to drive. Max length of sheet is 26'.
 - All sheet piles shall be new and un-spliced.
 - All sheet piles shall be straight and free of kinks.
- Install Sheet Pile at Station 4+00, 4+24 and 4+36
 - Approximately 115 LF of 26' Sheet Pile
 - Approximately 75 LF of 23' Sheet Pile
- GC to provide 30' wide, dry, level stabilized working pad for 150,000lb Pile Rig, within 6' of each sheeting installation location, and within 6' from Top of Pile.
- Blue Iron does not include splicing, cutting, patching, pairing, coating, cleaning, repairing, or any other modifications of sheet pile. This also means no touching up or patching of picking holes on sheet pile.
 - Blue Iron will not accept back charges for damage/liquidation to sheet pile from driving operation. GC to replace damaged sheet pile at no cost to Blue Iron.
- Blue Iron assumes sheeting can be installed using pre-drilling, vibratory/impact methods.
- Blue Iron assumes one continuous, uninterrupted operation for installation of sheet pile.
- GC to provide full time operated forklift/loader during entire installation process.
- Mobilization to project site is per occurrence.

1. GC to provide safe, level, firm, stabilized, accommodating, non-restrictive access/egress and work area as determined by Blue Iron for our equipment, crew, and materials at installation locations.
2. BI assumes piles can be installed using vibratory methods.
3. GC to provide operated forklift capable of picking 25,000 lbs for unloading and loading of vibro, counterweights, etc. as needed by Blue Iron.
4. GC to provide secure, adequate, on-site staging and storage area for equipment, tooling, and materials as required by Blue Iron for installation locations.
5. Blue Iron assumes pile locations are FREE of all overhead/underground utilities & obstructions, including overhead electrical. GC to coordinate removal, relocation, de-energizing or other means necessary for safe drilling and hoisting during pile installation.
6. Proposal is based on driving sheet pile to embedment depth or refusal, whichever occurs first. Refusal shall be determined BI by onsite foreman and is based on penetration of less than 2" in 5 minutes. Blue Iron will not accept back-charges for piles installed to refusal prior to embedment depth.
7. GC to perform all excavation and backfill operations.
8. GC to provide pile installation locations as work progresses, & grade checking for elevations as shoring is installed.
9. Proposal is based on normal working days/hours, Monday - Friday, 7 AM - 3:30 PM
10. GC to provide FRESH potholing for the driving operation as it progresses so that accurate locations of existing utilities may be determined and a method for dealing with such can be resolved in a timely manner. If utilities conflict with installation location, GC to remove & relocate prior to BI mobilization or stand by will occur.
11. 3' minimum horizontal clearance required between underground utilities and shoring.
12. GC to provide ALL traffic control, including any flagmen and lane closures that may be needed during pile installation.
13. GC to provide all ground improvements as necessary for separation in shoring due to pipe penetrations or other causes.
14. GC to provide shoring and/or encroachment permits including paying for any fees associated with permits.
15. GC will not back charge Blue Iron for any delay costs or prime contract liquidated damages.

16. GC to provide min 2' vertical clearance at top of pile. Either top 2' of pile to be exposed above ground surface, or min 2' deep trench to be provided along shoring line. In addition, a 3' clear space on both sides of shoring line is required.
17. GC to provide adequate functioning potable water or equivalent (city pressure-100 psi) within 100' of daily work area, if requested by Blue Iron.
18. GC will not back charge Blue Iron for any settlement to adjacent areas, roadways, structures and/or underground utilities due to normal deflection of the shoring system.
19. GC to remove all curbs, gutters, sidewalks, AC in location of shoring. Blue Iron not responsible for any damage to surfaces by the use of track equipment. Blue Iron shall not be back-charged for any surfaces damaged by track equipment that are not protected by the GC.

If obstructions are encountered GC to pay for standby of equipment and labor from the time the obstruction is hit, until the time that the obstruction is removed.

1. Mobilization: Payment for mobilization shall be paid in the first monthly progress payment. If additional mobilizations are to occur please add \$10,000.00 to contract price.
2. Progress Payment: In accordance with mutually agreed schedule of values due and payable thirty days after receipt of our monthly billing or ten days after receipt of payment from owner, whichever occurs first.
3. Retention: Shall not apply.
4. Materials on Hand: All on-site production materials delivered to the site to be paid in full thirty (30) days after receipt of our invoice, or ten (10) days after receipt of payment from owner, whichever comes first.
5. Unless specified otherwise, extra items of work not included in our scope of work, but performed by Blue Iron, or delays resulting from interference or non-performance of others, shall be invoiced at cost plus 20%.
6. If the owner / contractor asks blue iron to prepare submissions, secure materials, purchase or modify equipment and accessories or perform contract related work, prior to the contract document being finalized, all costs incurred, will be paid for at cost plus 20%.

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS: Scope of work reflects the following general conditions and general terms and shall be considered part of this proposal.

1. This proposal is good for a period of thirty (30) days only. Due to fluctuations in material supply, no price guarantee shall exist beyond the thirty (30) day period.
2. This proposal shall be incorporated into any Subcontract Agreement.
3. The schedule of work shall be mutually agreeable to both parties.
