Dear State Agency and Department,

We represent Synergy Project Management, Inc. ("Synergy"), the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the above-referenced project ("the Project"). This letter constitutes Synergy's written statement in support of its protest of the intent to award by the California Department of Transportation ("Caltrans") of the contract for the Project to a nonresponsive bidder, Windsor Fuel Co. ("Windsor"). Synergy submitted a notice of this protest to both Caltrans and the Department of General Services on March 14, 2013. This intended award is improper because Synergy, not Windsor, is the lowest responsive bidder, and because Windsor's bid is materially nonresponsive.

Windsor's bid is nonresponsive because Windsor lacks the proper license to perform the work for the Project. Windsor is not properly licensed as required for two portions of the work which its bid indicates it will self-perform: (1) it lacks the Class C specialty license required to self-perform the traffic control work; and (2) it lacks the Class A general engineering license necessary to perform the project as a whole (while Windsor is on record with the CSLB as holding a the Class A license, that license is automatically suspended by virtue of Windsor's lack of a proper Qualifying General Partner).

On the other hand, Synergy is properly licensed, and its bid is fully responsive. Therefore, Caltrans must withdraw its intended award to Windsor and award this contract, if at all, to Synergy.

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I. GROUNDS FOR PROTEST

A. Caltrans Cannot Award the Contract to Windsor Because Windsor Is Not Properly Licensed for at Least Two Portions of the Project

1. Windsor lacks the required license for traffic control work that its bid indicates it will self-perform

A bidder on public works is required to "designate what portion of the work will be done by each subcontractor." *Bay Cities Paving & Grading, Inc. v. Hensel Phelps Constr. Co.*, 56 Cal App 3d 361, 365 (1976) (citing Pub. Cont. Code §4104(b)). If the bidder fails to list a subcontractor for any portion of work that is in excess of one-half of one percent of the total bid, then the bidder is deemed to have listed itself to self-perform that work. Public Contract Code §4106.

Here, Windsor's List of Subcontractors designates Linear Options ("Linear") for only "4%" of the Traffic Control work at the Project (Bid Item No. 3). See Exhibit 1, Windsor's Bid to Caltrans, p. 5. Thus, Windsor is obligated to self-perform the 96% of the traffic control work that Linear will not perform. However, a C-31 "Construction Zone Traffic Control Contractor" license is required to perform this work. 16 CCR §832.31. Windsor does not have a C-31 license. Exh. 2, Windsor's Contractor's License Detail.

California law mandates that Windsor possess all required licenses to perform its work prior to award of the contract if it involves federal funding, and prior to even submitting its bid if there is no federal funding. Pub. Cont. Code § 20103.5 (federal funding); Bus. & Prof. Code §7028.15(a) (no federal funding). A bid submitted by a contractor like Windsor that is not properly licensed must be considered nonresponsive and rejected by the public agency. Bus. & Prof. Code §7028.15(e). As Windsor did not possess the required C-31 license to self-perform traffic control when it submitted its bid, and still does not, its bid is nonresponsive and must be rejected.

2. Windsor's Class A license is invalid

The Project's Notice to Bidders requires bidders to have either a Class A license or a C-12 "Earthwork and Paving Contractor" license. Exh. 3, Notice to Bidders, p. 1. Windsor does not have a C-12 license. Exh. 2, Windsor's Contractor's License Detail. And, while it does have a Class A engineering license, which would normally entitle it to do the work, that license is invalid because Windsor's Qualifying Partner has exceeded the statutory limit on the number of firms he may qualify.

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A qualifying individual for a contractor's license "may act as the qualifier for no more than three firms in any one year period." Bus. & Prof. Code §7068.1(d). Additionally, a person may not act as the qualifying individual for any additional firm, even within the three-firm limit, unless: (a) there is common ownership of at least 20 percent; (b) the additional firm is a subsidiary or joint venture of the first; or (c) the majority of partners, officers or managers are the same. Bus. & Prof. Code §7068.1(a)-(c).

Here, Windsor's Class A license is qualified by Michael Stephen Telfer, as of March 30, 2000. Exh. 2, Windsor's Contractor's License Detail (Personnel List). However, Mr. Telfer was already qualifying the maximum of three construction firms at that time with his Class A license: (1) Continental Western Transportation Co., Inc. as of June 16, 1988; (2) his sole-proprietorship as of August 27, 1992; and (3) Telfer Oil Company as of March 29, 2000. Exh. 4, Continental's Contractor's License Detail (Personnel List); Exh. 5, Telfer Sole Ownership's Contractor's License Detail (Personnel List); Exh. 6, Telfer Oil's Contractor's License Detail (Personnel List). Thus, Mr. Telfer is prohibited from qualifying Windsor's Class A, thereby necessarily automatically suspending this license.

In addition, even if Mr. Telfer were within the three-firm limit, Windsor's Class A license would still be invalid because Windsor fails to meet any of the criteria that would permit it as an additional firm under Mr. Telfer's license. Continental was Mr. Telfer's first qualified firm, and it is apparent from Continental's personnel list that it does not share a majority of partners, officers or managers with Windsor. Continental's officers are as follows: Ronald Cook; John Telfer; Mr. Telfer; Judith Telfer; Wilma Telfer; and James Leslie Fletcher. Exh. 4. Windsor's partners are: Mr. Telfer; Telfer Tank Lines, Inc.; Asphalt Service Co.; and Telfer Enterprises, Inc. Exh. 2. Mr. Telfer himself is the only common officer/partner, and he does not constitute a majority.

Furthermore, the officers and partners of construction firms are generally the owners of those firms. Since Mr. Telfer is only one of the six officers listed for Continental (i.e. 16.6 percent), it does not appear that Windsor shares 20 percent common ownership with Continental.

Finally, there is no indication that Windsor is a subsidiary or joint venture of Continental. Thus, Mr. Telfer cannot meet any of the additional requirements of Business & Professions Code section 7068.1(a)-(c), and so may not act as the qualifying individual for Windsor.

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Since Windsor's required Class A license is invalid, its bid is nonresponsive and must be rejected. Additionally, as Windsor lacks the license to perform the work, Caltrans is statutorily obligated to reject Windsor's bid. Bus. & Prof. Code §7028.15(e).

B. Caltrans Should Award the Contract to Synergy Because Synergy's Bid Is Responsive


Unlike Windsor's improper bid, Synergy's bid for the Project is fully responsive. Synergy provided all required information in its bid. See Exh. 7, Synergy's Bid to Caltrans. Significantly, Synergy has a proper Class A license, and its responsible qualifying officer, Javad Mirsaidi, is not qualifying any other firms. See Exh. 8, Synergy's Contractor's License Detail; Exh. 9, Personnel License List for Javad Mirsaidi. Moreover, Synergy has a C-31 license, so it is permitted to self-perform the Traffic Control work. Exh. 8.

Synergy understands that, other than the nonresponsive bid from Windsor, Synergy submitted the lowest bid for the Project. Thus, Synergy is the lowest responsive bidder, and Caltrans should award the contract to Synergy.

II. CONCLUSION

Windsor's bid is materially nonresponsive because Windsor lacks the required licenses to perform the work at the Project. Synergy's bid, in contrast, is fully responsive. Accordingly, Caltrans should cancel its intended award to Windsor and award the contract to Synergy.
