



- **Radios:** Our flaggers and pilot car(s) will be equipped with VHF or UHF 2-way radios. Additionally, pilot cars are equipped with CB radios for coordination with your truckers and other CB-equipped equipment.
- **Rental equipment** (excludes non-powered devices): For this project, the Portable Changeable Message Signs are covered herein under. The Prime Contractor shall be responsible for any damage or loss to/of the equipment due to traffic conflicts, vandalism, theft, acts of nature or mishandling by Prime Contractor's staff. The Prime Contractor will NOT be responsible for maintenance of the operational capabilities, except for operational difficulties and repairs brought about by such traffic conflicts, vandalism, acts of nature or mishandling by Prime Contractor's staff.
- **Night Work:** (a) No increase is applicable to any labor rates quoted above; (b) All added costs associated with illuminating the flaggers stations shall be borne by the Prime Contractor; (c) we will provide the two required 12" flashing beacons @ \$6 each per night.
