If areas are to be left open for any reason & item not able to be completed an additional mobilization cost of \$475 minimum must be paid.
2. Any and all embeds or other buried improvements by others to be in place prior to start of R&R's work.
3. GC SHALL be ready for all work requested to be completed upon R&R's arrival to job site.
Work to be ready for completion in an "uninterrupted" manner.
4. No painting of concrete surfaces. No A/C Plug or pour back thereof. Any existing A/C to be 1 ft. away .
from gutter lip. No Bollard work unless specifically stated under "Inclusions".
5. No permits or governmental fees of any kind. No testing or inspections of any kind.
Concrete Washout if required to be supplied by GC.
6. General Contractor/Owner responsible for all soil conditions. No compaction responsibilities unless specifically noted.
Water to be provided on-site and made readily available and accessible by GC / Owner.
7. Sub-Grade to be within 1 inch. No Pea Gravel or Base Rock. No import or export of fill dirt. No back fill.

8. No responsibility for security, erosion or weather protection of area(s). NO SWPPP. No Cold Weather Blankets.
9. No additional Bonding Fees or costs of any kind.
10. No responsibility of any subterranean utility, electrical or gas lines that have not been readily identified in the area of construction.
11. Not responsible for weather conditions and acts of nature or strikes that may negatively affect the work schedule or work performed.
12. No hauling of dirt spoils. No hauling of job debris not directly associated with included bid item(s).
13. No Doweling / Epoxy, type curbs and pre-cast wheel stops. No Fabrics. - UNLESS specifically stated above.

18. Unless specifically stated under inclusions: No removal of obstructions, blasting of rock, removal of preexisting concrete, jack-hammering, drilling, or saw cutting. No concrete boring.
19. Removal of standing flood or rain / mud water not included.
20. All areas for service to provide concrete accessibility and operations. No pumping unless otherwise specified on bid under "inclusions". Area to be clear of any obstructions that limit concrete truck access to service areas of improvement. Concrete improvements shall be done in a manner that allows for tailgate placement of all concrete.
21. Bid proposal good for 20 days from date of submission. GC must by phone, fax or confirmed email notify R&R of intent to award within 5 days of bid submission.
22. Not responsible nor included in bid repair of neighboring or associated landscape or sprinkler lines.
23. This document shall be incorporated in full to the Owner's and or General Contractor's Sub-Contractor Agreement and may not be preempted. If R&R performs any work on any job under this or any subsequent agreement it is assumed all provisions as set forth in this document are agreed to by the GC and or Owner. - No Exceptions.

25. R&R must be listed as a subcontractor by General Contractor for proposal to be valid.
