

ADDENDA ACKNOWLEDGED:

1. Cal Stripe Inc.'s subcontract proposal is good for 60 days only. Prices are based on Plans & Specifications available at bid time including all addenda.
2. If this proposal is accepted, it is to be incorporated as an exhibit to the Contract or purchase order. A signed purchase order, or subcontract is required prior to commencement of any work associated with this proposal. A baseline schedule, complete set of plans and specs (including special provisions) will be provided with the subcontract agreement.
3. Contractor to provide monthly progress payments for all completed work in accordance with the bid pricing schedule. Monthly progress payments must be received in full by Cal Stripe no later than 10 calendar days after the Contractor receives payment from Owner. Retention percentage on monthly progress payments to be no greater than the percentage retained by the Owner on its payments to the Contractor. 8. Traffic control plans are not included. All lane closure requests are to be submitted by the Prime contractor.


