Governed by the terms and conditions attached hereto we propose to install the following:

- Furnish and install 4 each 72"Ø x 20.25' deep CIDH piles.

ESCALATION: The Principal Sum quoted herein is valid provided this Proposal is accepted within 10 days from the date hereon, and the work is completed by July 2017, however The Mahaffey Companies ("TMC") reserves the right to adjust its' prices at any time to allow for any price increases for its' cost of labor and purchase of material under the prevailing market conditions. All material included in the Principal Sum is subject to prior sale.

SECTION 1. THE ABOVE PRICES SHOWN SPECIFICALLY INCLUDES ONLY THE FOLLOWING WORK DESCRIPTION:

- Drilling for the installation of the CIDH piles.
- Furnish and place concrete. For wet-hole pile construction methods, Client is responsible to have full-time inspection for immediate approval to place concrete when TMC is ready to place concrete. Wet-hole piles will not be vibrated. Washout areas shall be supplied, maintained and disposed of by others. Above-grade forming for pedestals is excluded.
- Machine power only to hoist reinforcing steel furnished by others to a maximum 5-feet above existing grade. All excavating, if required to facilitate the installation of reinforcing cage extensions and / or dowels is to be performed by others in a schedule and sequence so as to not delay TMC's work.
- Principal Sum is based on drilling using Caltrans wet-hole construction methods. Placement, clearing for testing and grouting of PVC inspection pipes is included.
- Obstruction drilling (excavating materials which cannot be drilled / constructed with conventional earth augers and are either not indicated or mis-indicated on the project soil borings) is not included in the Principal Sum. Obstruction drilling time will be documented on TMC Daily Work Tickets and signed by an authorized Representative of the Contractor on a timely basis. All such time will be charged at the rate of \$1,550.00 per hour per rig and is in addition to the Principal Sum above. Dispute and / or refusal to acknowledge and sign for obstruction drilling as documented will be cause for cessation of work until such disagreement is resolved by an authorized representative of TMC. Obstruction drilling is not change order work.
- Dry, level, continuous, unobstructed access is to be provided and maintained by others to within 5-foot horizontal reach of center at the top of each pile cutoff elevation for all equipment and material trucks moving under their own power.
- All abutments, bents, pile caps and/or grade beam excavations shall be performed by others in a schedule and sequence agreed to in writing by TMC in advance.
- All extra work will be charged in addition to the unit prices.

SECTION 2. TERMS OF PAYMENT.

100% of monthly progress payments (in accordance with a pre contract schedule of values) shall be paid within 30-days of Invoice date. Full and final payment shall be made no later than 45-days of TMC's demobilization. Retention shall not be withheld. If payment or any portion thereof is delinquent, Client agrees to pay, in addition to any and all delinquent amounts, 2.0% per month or 24% annual rate as liquidated damages on the unpaid balance. The parties acknowledge that such charges are reasonable considering all the circumstances existing on the date of this Agreement, including (1) the relationship of the charges to the range of harm that TMC can reasonably anticipate; and (2) the anticipation that proof of actual damages would be costly or inconvenient as a result of the failure to make payment when due. TMC's payments are not contingent upon payment to Client by others. Past due payments may be cause for cessation of TMC's work.

SECTION 3. TO BE FURNISHED BY OTHERS AT NO COST TO TMC:

1. **ACCESS** safe, suitable and timely for all personnel and for all equipment and material trucks moving under their own power without mats to all areas of work. Access includes but is not limited to furnishing of materials, acceptable ramps, benches and maintenance of same, including access for placement of concrete via chute directly from mixer truck.
2. **REMOVAL**, relocation or protection of any existing utilities, power lines, structures, sidewalks, curbs, gutters and/or landscaping either above or below ground, which may interfere with the installation of TMC's work, whether or not depicted on any contract documents. Power lines closer than legally permissible are to be removed or de-energized by others. When Client request TMC to commence work on the above referenced construction project, that request will constitute Client's representation to TMC that it has located all above or below ground utilities, structures, sidewalks, curbs, gutters and/or landscaping and that Client has taken all necessary and appropriate action to ensure that the work to be performed by TMC can be performed safely without any threat of injury or damage to persons or property. Client is responsible for all "Dig Alert" notifications and interpretations and ensuring that drilling locations do not impact existing utilities and / or facilities. Provide "Dig Alert" number _____ and initials _____.
3. TMC is not responsible for underground pile irregularities ("blow-outs", "mushrooms" "blow-togethers", etc.) revealed by excavation. TMC is not responsible for delay time due to Owner analysis and response to pile testing. TMC is not responsible for providing a particular aesthetic finish to any subsequently excavated piles.
4. **PREPARATION** for, performance of and extra work required by non-destructive pile testing is excluded. Load testing of piles is excluded.
5. **ALL FIELD ENGINEERING**, transit and level work as required by TMC to clearly mark and accurately confirm the top of rebar cage and concrete elevation in addition to center hubs, reinforced points and grade stakes for concrete and steel placement at each pier and/or pile location and maintenance of same. Contractor is solely responsible for ensuring that drilling locations do not impact existing utilities and / or facilities.
6. **ALL LEGAL SERVICES** necessary to hold TMC harmless and defend TMC in litigation arising out of or pertaining to discovering, encountering, handling, or exposing toxic or hazardous wastes as described by the United States Government.
7. **HANDLING**, disposal and/or removal of spoils (liquid or solid including but not limited to dirt, mud, rock, concrete, slurry, water, drilling fluids, any materials expelled by the shaft or any other by-product) resulting from all phases of pile installation operations from rebar, pile caps, grade beams, footings, streets, access roads, alleys and/or jobsite and to be done on a continuous basis so as not to delay TMC. Concrete washout areas are to be provided, maintained and disposed of by others. It is a condition of this bid and any subsequent contract based on this bid that the owner assumes all responsibility for the removal, handling and/or disposal of toxic or hazardous wastes including asbestos. TMC assumes and will assume no responsibility for the removal, handling and/or disposal of such toxic or hazardous waste. All work shall be performed in a level 'D' working environment.
8. **JOBSITE SECURITY** to avoid vandalism and/or theft of our equipment and materials. All costs related to the replacement and/or repair, including lost time, of our equipment and materials due to vandalism and/or theft.
9. **TRAFFIC CONTROL**, material handling plans or traffic protection equipment, labor, watchmen, street cleaning, dewatering systems, potable water source, electrical power, construction lighting and sanitation facilities are to be located not more than one hundred feet (100') from TMC' drilling and/or driving operations.
10. **ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROLS** (noise, vibration, exhaust fumes and any other environmental hazards or annoyances) are excluded from the Proposal.
11. **ALL REQUIRED ONSITE** permits, as-built drawings, shop drawings, inspections, observations, monitoring, materials design, surveys, easements, testing of any type, inspection reports, personal protection equipment, and/or Confined Space Entry requirements. Any "down-hole" inspections shall be performed at the sole risk of the Contractor and shall exclude the use of any of TMC' equipment and/or personnel.

12. **PLACEMENT** of dowels, anchor bolts, keys or any formwork above or below existing grade, concrete curing or chipping, sandblasting, structural steel and/or pile extensions, protective coverings and/or hole covers for shafts and/or rebar.
13. **WHEN** reinforcing cages are to be hoisted by TMC, the material is to be furnished and fabricated by others and delivered sufficiently dished and braced with welded rings to retain their shape during handling. Delivery of each cage is to be made to each shaft location within a 10-foot reach of TMC equipment. Rebar cages will be placed a maximum of 5-feet above top of pile elevation or existing grade. Should TMC include in its' scope of work setting rebar cages extending more than 5-feet above existing grade, it is the Contractor's responsibility to secure and maintain accurate positioning of rebar extending above pile cut off elevation and to detach the cage rigging from the cage above grade.
14. **SUFFICIENT** on-site area shall be provided for TMC to set up an office, and to store and/or fabricate materials.
15. **SHOULD** it become necessary for TMC to pump fluids from the shafts, a sump, holding tank, Baker tank, desilting basin or any other adequate type of containment shall be furnished, cleaned and maintained by others within fifty feet (50') of each shaft location.
16. **CONSTRUCTION WATER** for the drilling operation as specified by TMC will be within fifty feet (50') of each shaft location.
17. **SHOULD** Client require work to be performed in addition to that specifically described herein, all such work will be charged in addition to the principal sum, at **Extra Work Rates**.
18. **NOTIFICATION** and interpretation of Dig Alert.

SECTION 4. GENERAL CONDITIONS.

1. **UNLESS SPECIFIED** in our work description, only conventional earth auger tools will be used. Work items such as casing, rock drilling, coring, dewatering, hand-mining, hand-cleaning, shoring of bells, etc. will be charged at the delay and / or obstruction rate in addition to the Principal Sum and / or Unit Prices. This work is not change order work. All daily work tickets must be approved and signed for on a daily basis. TMC reserves the right to stop work until any dispute regarding delay and / or obstruction is resolved.
2. **REMOVAL** of any obstruction as defined by the International Association of Foundation Drilling Contractors and the U.S. Department of Transportation will be extra work and charged in addition to the principal sum and/or unit prices. Obstructions are defined as "any material which cannot be drilled with a conventional earth auger and/or underreaming tool and which requires the use of special rock augers, core barrels, air tools, blasting, and/or other methods of hand excavation. All earth seams, rock fragments, and voids included in this rock excavation area will be considered rock for the full volume of the shaft from initial contact with rock, for pay purposes." Determination of when drilling conditions necessitate the use of special rock augers, core barrels, air tools, blasting, and/or other methods of hand excavation shall be at the sole discretion of TMC.




