The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received a bid submitted by Ybanag Realty and Development Corporation dba D'Ybanag Construction Co. (D'Ybanag) for Contract 07-2W6504 on February 5, 2015. By this letter, Caltrans notifies D'Ybanag that its bid is nonresponsive. The bidding instructions on the Subcontractors List form states that the bidder must set forth in the bid, the name, the location of the place of business, the California contractor license number, and the portion of work of each subcontractor who will perform. The Bidder, must submit within 24 hours of the bid opening, the bid item numbers with percentages of the portion of work subcontracted.

On bid day, D'Ybanag listed the following subcontractors; Sapperwest, Orange County Striping and Abrasive Blasting Service. On the 24 hour submittal, D'Ybanag listed the same three subcontractors and added Extreme Pressure Systems, Inc. The addition of this subcontractor constitutes an improper change to the Subcontractor's List form, which is in violation of the bidding instructions, as well as the Public Contract Code.

Based on the above, Caltrans will proceed to award this contract to the lowest responsible bidder, provided that all requirements have been met.

Your attention is directed to Section 3-1.04 of the 2010 Standard Specifications. Caltrans is not obligated to offer an extension of the award period for a nonresponsive bid. Should you wish to extend your bid while resolving a nonresponsive finding, you must send your request to the Office Engineer no later than 4:00 p.m., two business days prior to the expiration of your bid.



By this letter, Caltrans notifies D'Ybanag that its bid is nonresponsive. The bidding instructions on the Subcontractors List form states that the bidder must set forth in the bid, the name, the location of the place of business, the California contractor license number, and the portion of work of each subcontractor who will perform. The Bidder, must submit within 24 hours of the bid opening, the bid item numbers with percentages of the portion of work subcontracted.

On bid day, D'Ybanag listed the following subcontractors; Sappervest, Orange County Striping and Abrasive Blasting Service. On the 24 hour submittal, D'Ybanag listed the same three subcontractors and added Extreme Pressure Systems, Inc. The addition of this subcontractor constitutes an improper change to the Subcontractor's List form, which is in violation of the bidding instructions, as well as the Public Contract Code.

Based on the above, Caltrans will proceed to award this contract to the lowest responsible bidder, provided that all requirements have been met.

Your attention is directed to Section 3-1.04 of the 2010 Standard Specifications. Caltrans is not obligated to offer an extension of the award period for a nonresponsive bid.
