Notice of Award Rescission

Dear Mr. O'Donnell:

Bids were opened on February 24, 2015, for Bridge Rehabilitation and Approach Slab Repair in Riverside and San Bernardino Counties on routes 15, 60, 138 and 215 at various locations.

This project was awarded to your company on March 6, 2015. Subsequent to the award, the Department of Transportation determined that the bid submitted by O'Donnell was nonresponsive and due to an administrative error was awarded to O'Donnell.

O'Donnell listed Quality Traffic Control (Quality) on its Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Commitment form to perform work described as bid item 3 (Traffic Control System) and provided a description of work as Attenuator Vehicle with Driver and claimed DBE participation for this subcontractor in the amount of \$18,200.00. The bidding instructions for submitting the Subcontractors List form found in the 2010 Standard Specifications, Section 2-1.10, states in part... "The bidder must identify each subcontractor performing work in an amount in excess of 1/2 of 1 percent of the total bid or \$10,000, whichever is greater." O'Donnell failed to list Quality on the Subcontractor List form.

Furthermore, the aforementioned bid item 3 meets the requirements that define a contractor under the Business and Professions Code 7025 (et. seq.) and the total amount of work provided to Quality exceeded the requirements of Public Contract Code 4100 (et. seq.), and as such, Quality should have been listed as a subcontractor.

Based on the above finding, the Department rescinds the award to O'Donnell. Please return all contract documents sent to you, at the address noted above.
