A spider excavator will be onsite. Use of this equipment, with operator, is available to the GC at \$350/hr. This does not include the drill.

**Conditions:**

Bid item 30, Roadway Excavation, is a partial bid item that only includes the slope rounding work listed as 75 CY on sheet 44. The Scaling work includes hauling off and disposing of the scaled rock. General Contractor may need to sweep after work is finished. Bid items 30 and 35 can be excluded by GC, if desired. All other bid items are not splittable; use all or none.

Carlson's Construction will supply all labor, equipment and materials needed to perform the work in the bid items listed above unless noted otherwise. No backcharges are permitted without the consent of Carlson's Construction. Costs for bonding are not included in this bid. All sums not paid when due shall be charged 1-1/2% per month from due date until paid or the maximum rate permitted by law whichever is less; and all costs of collection, including reasonable attorney's fees, shall be paid by the General Contractor. This bid will be attached to, and become a part of, any contract entered into by Carlson's Construction. All conditions listed herein shall override any conflicting conditions listed in the General Contractor's contract.
