- 2) Modification to the work may require a change in the quote.
- 3) Unless otherwise indicated the unit prices are based on ABSL performing all the work included on the proposal. If ABSL does not receive a contract for all the work, the unit prices are subject to adjustment.
- 4) The unit prices are based on the estimated quantities in the bid proposal. If the quantity of the item changes by 25% or more the unit price is subject to equitable adjustment.
- 5) All teeth over one complete set will be charge to the contractor.
- 6) Prices are good for 30 days from the date of this proposal, after that date the prices are subject to adjustment.
- 7) In the event there is an increase in the cost of fuel of more than \$0.50 per gallon during the performance of this contract, ABSL will be entitled to a \$75.00 per day fuel surcharge. - 8) If ABSL cannot proceed with its work as scheduled due to others, standby time will be charged at the following rate: \$500.00 per hour.

2. Acceptance:

Quote is void 20days after bid opening without returned signed notice of intent.

This Trucking quote sets forth the entire agreement between CTI and Customer with respect to its subject matters.

No terms, conditions, or modifications other than those cited herein shall be binding on CTI unless made in writing and signed by CTI.

Terms and conditions herein are automatically incorporated into any purchase order/master haul agreement between CTI and customer.

CTI shall not be liable for performance issues beyond its control which shall be defined to include, but not limited to, actual or threatened strikes, labor disputes, boycotts, work stoppages, schedule changes, owner changes, inclement weather, fire, flood, embargos, or war.

CTI shall not be liable for any labor or union agreements customer has entered into.

3. Trucking Services:

Quote is for the import/export of materials and onsite work only, pricing does not reflect material costs unless stated as "delivered" price.

All activities are subject to equipment and material availability.

Hauling shall be performed in accordance with a schedule mutually agreed upon by the customer and CTI.

Quote from a source does not guarantee material availability. Prices are quoted in US tons.

Customer shall be responsible for material abiding by project specifications and/or regulations.

For open-grade, rubber, and bonded wearing course a suitable release agent, orange peel or equivalent, must be provided at plant.

All dirt must be clean 4" or smaller in size, free of broken concrete, asphalt, rebar, metal, or objects which may cause equipment damage.

4. Standby Time:

Transfers allotted 10min load/20min unload for dirt-aggregates, 15min load/30min unload for asphalt

Bottom dumps allotted 10min load/10min unload for dirt-aggregates, 15min load/15min unload for asphalt.

Time exceeding time allotments will be billed as standby at rate of \$1.30 per minute for all truck types.

5. Price Escalations:

Haul quote is valid until 12/31/2015 with a 5% yearly increase thereafter.

Quote based on \$4.00/gallon diesel listed at <http://www.eia.gov/petroleum/gasdiesel/>, a 1% increase will apply for every \$0.10 increase

Quote does NOT reflect any Prevailing or Davis-Bacon wage rates, Add 30% if required.

Bridge tolls to be billed as an additional per load cost when applicable unless noted otherwise.

Quote based on entire project award, price adjustment may be necessary for partial scope.

Per load pricing based on full legal 80,000lb loads, overweight tickets will be billed to customer where scales are not present.

6. Terms of Payment:

Customer shall pay CTI at the prices quoted above ("1. Haul Rates"). Standard payment terms are net thirty(30)days or credit limit.

Established credit limit is a combined \$ amount per customer, not a per job basis. If credit limit is reached prior to 30 days, payment will be due before trucks can be dispatched. CTI is not responsible for costs incurred due to customer not following payment terms.

Customer shall pay all invoices in their entirety without retention of any amounts.

Customer's failure to pay all amounts owing when due shall be deemed a breach of agreement and CTI may, at its option,

(i) terminate this haul quote, (ii) require payment to be made in advance of future hauling, or

(iii) place future hauling on a C.O.D. basis. Amounts past due shall bear an interest charge computed from the due date

at a rate of 1.5% per month, 18% annual rate. Customer agrees to pay all costs and expenses of collecting past due accounts, including actual attorney's fees, incurred whether or not a suit or action is filed, on appeal or otherwise.

7. Miscellaneous:

CTI will contact job foreman prior to unloading if jobsite conditions may cause equipment damage, equipment getting stuck, utility or property damage. If instructed to proceed, CTI assumes no liability for costs incurred by damages. CTI should be advised within

one (1) day of any incident on the job that will result in pay deduction or back charge. Both parties agree to discuss and resolve

incident within three (3) days of occurrence. If parties can't reach a mutual agreement customer indemnifies and holds CTI

harmless for costs or damages incurred, or to be incurred, due to CTI's quote termination and service withdrawal from project.

Each project quote is independent; no pay is to be withheld from one project to compensate incidents on another project.

Use of CTI quote and/or services is acceptance of the terms and conditions herein and is deemed a fully executed agreement.


