

Clarifications:

1. Indemnity - The subcontractor shall not be obligated under this Agreement to indemnify the indemnities with respect to injuries or damages which are determined to be due to the negligence or willful misconduct of the indemnities.

2. Schedule - The schedule shall be mutually agreed upon by Contractor and Subcontractor. The contractor may from time to time, make reasonable adjustments to the schedule which the Subcontractor shall adhere to. Should it become necessary to make unreasonable adjustments to the schedule, the Subcontractor will identify his cost for such adjustments to the Contractor plus 15% for overhead and profit for reimbursement by the Contractor.

3. Payment from Owner to Contractor is not a condition precedent to Contractor paying Subcontractor. Contractor shall pay Ahrens 10 days after Contractor is paid by owner or 45 days from date of Ahrens' invoice, which ever occurs first. Interest shall accrue at 10% per annum. If contractor desires to remove this provision, the proposal price shall be increased 10%.

4. Bonds, if required, shall be paid directly by Contractor. If contractor desires Ahrens to pay for bond, Contractor shall reimburse Ahrens the actual cost of bonds plus an additional 3% of overall subcontract. Bonds, if required, shall be requested at the beginning of contract.

5. Ahrens does not extend personal guarantees.

6. In the event of subcontract termination, for any reason, Contractor does not have the right to seize Ahrens' tools and equipment on the job site nor does contractor have right to "Set Off" amounts due on other contracts with Ahrens.

7. This proposal shall be part of and attached to the subcontract and shall supercede any other portion of the subcontract. The proposal can only be modified in writing by Gregory S. Ahrens.

8. Ahrens Corporation is not signatory to any Labor Agreements. Ahrens will employee Operators, Laborers, Carpenters, Plumbers, Pipefitters, Sheet Metal Workers, and Welders on this project. Neither Ahrens, Ahrens' employees, nor Ahrens' subcontractors shall be required to sign any agreement with any union, PLA, or PSA.

9. Insurance - Ahrens Mechanical and Ahrens Mechanical's subcontractors will provide the following insurance coverage. Any additionally coverage, increase in coverage, special forms, etc will be additional cost payable by the Contractor.

- a. Broadform Comprehensive General Liability. Coverage in minimum limits of \$2,000,000.00 General Aggregate and \$1,000,000.00 for each accident or occurrence.
- b. Automotive Liability. Coverage in minimum limits of \$1,000,000.00 for each injury or death of any person; \$1,000,000.00 for each accident or occurrence; and \$1,000,000.00 for each accident or occurrence for property damage.
- c. Worker's Compensation. As required by Federal and State worker's compensation and occupational disease laws.
- d. Umbrella. \$ None

Add \$5,000.00 for each \$1,000,000.00 increase in insurance. For all other insurance changes Contractor shall reimburse Ahrens Corporation actual cost plus 10% within 15 days of Ahrens invoicing Contractor.

10. Ahrens Mechanical has not reviewed nor does Ahrens Mechanical accept contractors standard contract.




