Dear Mr. Niknafs:

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received a bid submitted by Pro Tech Engineering Corporation (Pro Tech) for Contract 12-0L3004 on January 10, 2013. By this letter, Caltrans notifies Pro Tech that its bid is nonresponsive because it did not comply with the Contract Special Provision Section 2-1.02, DISABLED VETERAN BUSINESS ENTERPRISES, which states in part:

“... Meet the goal shown on the Notice to Bidders.”

The DVBE Contract goal is 5 percent. Pro Tech claimed 1.2 percent participation.

Based on the above, Caltrans will award the contract to the lowest responsive bidder.

Your attention is directed to Section 3-1.02 of the Amendments to the 2006 Standard Specifications. Caltrans is not obligated to offer an extension of the award period for a nonresponsive bid. Should you wish to extend your bid while resolving a nonresponsive finding, you must send your request to the Office Engineer no later than 4:00 pm, two business days prior to the expiration of your bid.
