DISSEMINATION OF POLICY

Sully-Miller Contracting Company has established various channels of communication to ensure that employees and the community are aware of the Company's positive posture regarding equal employment opportunity and affirmative action.

INTERNAL DISSEMINATION

The Affirmative Action Policy is stated as part of Sully-Miller Contracting Company's employee relation's policy and is covered in our collective bargaining agreements.

Formal presentations are made to management, supervisors and employees on a monthly basis concerning affirmative action. If hiring is taking place, regular updates are given to management on progress in remedying under-utilized areas. The unions are formally made aware of this policy.

In management and supervisory training, the entire concept of affirmative action is covered. Our policy and its implementation are reviewed. Key management and support personnel periodically undergo EEO and affirmative action training.

Our Equal Employment Opportunity Officer has received formal EEO training by attending the National Employment Law Institute's seminars on Affirmative Action, Sexual Harassment and the Americans with Disabilities Act.

The Equal Employment Opportunity Officer is a member of the Equal Employment Opportunity Committee of the Associated General Contractors and Special Seminars/Training Subcommittee as well as the Emerging Contractors Committee.

When hiring takes place, new employees receive copies of the Company's Equal Employment Opportunity and Affirmative Action policies. Copies of these documents have been distributed to supervisory personnel and are posted in conspicuous places at each office and job site trailer for inspection by any company employee and applicants for employment.

"Equal Opportunity Employer" posters are posted in conspicuous places at the Company job sites and that phrase is used in all advertisements for employment with the Company.

When employees are featured in any employee publication, minorities and women are included.

EXTERNAL DISSEMINATION

As part of our communications policy, we notify the state job service and appropriate recruiting sources and the main offices of the unions with which we deal of the Company's policy concerning equal employment opportunity and affirmative action. When hiring occurs, we request referral of qualified women and minorities for all positions. We also contact organizations which can refer women in non-traditional employment roles.

Our customers, contractors and various community groups have been notified of our policies. Sully-Miller Contracting Company communicates its commitment to equal employment opportunity by recruitment advertising through regular media and through minority and women's publications.

Written notification of EEO policy, as well as requests for certification regarding compliance with equal employment opportunity laws, is sent to suppliers and subcontractors. The required EEO clauses are incorporated as part of purchase orders and contracts.

All subcontractors, vendors, labor unions with which the Company has contracts and potential sources of employees, such as schools, employment agencies, colleges, etc. are informed of Sully-Miller's Affirmative Action commitment.

All "Help Wanted" advertisements carry the notice "Equal Employment Opportunity/Affirmative Action Employer".

RESPONSIBILITY FOR IMPLEMENTATION

David Martinez, President, has the ultimate responsibility for ensuring that equal employment opportunity and affirmative action receive the high level of priority which is due this activity.

Mary Lawson, Human Resources Manager, has been designated Equal Employment Opportunity Officer and has the full support of the Chief Executive Officer in carrying out these duties.

To implement this policy, the following activities are carried out:

- Keep management up to date concerning new development in the CCO field.
- Provide technical assistance in response to questions and concerns of employees and supervisors; as needed, act as liaison with appropriate agencies.
- Coordinate investigations and make recommendations concerning any allegations of discrimination, both internally and in connection with enforcement agencies.
- Conduct periodic audits and hold discussions with supervisors and managers to ensure that Company policy is implemented.
- Encourage involvement with minority and women's organizations and community action groups.
- Assist in the identification of problem areas through review of policies and procedures.
- Develop education programs to provide managers and supervisors with pertinent equal employment opportunity information to assist them in their compliance efforts.

AVAILABILITY ANALYSIS

As part of Sully-Miller's AAP, the factors to be considered in determining availability of minorities and women for job groups are detailed in 41 CFR 60-2.11 (b) (1) and (2).

Sully-Miller considers all of the following factors in determining whether minorities, women and applicable minority subgroups are being under-utilized in any job group:

- Minority and female population of the labor area surrounding the facility.

This is helpful information, but we do not feel it is relevant if recruiting and hiring is taking place. This information is for the total population, including those who are working, those seeking work and those who do not want to work or are unable to work.

- Size of the minority and female unemployment force in the labor area surrounding the facility.

While unemployment statistics are some indication of the number of people looking for work, it would be rare that our organization would consider a person who "walks in off the street". The Company contacts the applicable Union for operations jobs. Clerical jobs are posted, the state job service is contacted and employees are encouraged to refer qualified applicants.

- Availability of minorities and women having the requisite skills in the labor area.

This is the most important factor to us. Many of our operations jobs require training/experience to be performed safely. Apprentices are requested and provided from the Unions with which we have agreements. Organizations encouraging and providing training for women in non-traditional employment roles are emerging and have become a source for employees.

- Availability percentage of minorities and women having the requisite skills in the recruitment area.

For some jobs (managerial, technical sales, professional, etc., the recruitment area may be border than the local market area.

AVAILABILITY ANALYSIS (continued)

- The assistance of training institutions capable of training people in the requisite skills.

When hiring occurs at this facility, we try to find people with some experience and training in our type of work.

- The degree of training of prospective employees which the contractor is reasonably able to undertake.

Our employment needs focus to a large degree on people already trained for a job in our industry. We have few openings for beginners. If onsite training were to take place, applications would be solicited from all employees, including minorities and women. Apprentices are requested and provided by the Unions with which we have agreements. We have had a number of college students working in the administrative areas as summer interns.

IDENTIFICATION OF PROBLEM AREAS

We have examined the composition of our Workforce by organizational unit, job group, personnel actions and the specific items listed in 41 CFR 60-2.23 to identify and deficiencies. Based on our review, our findings are listed:

- Workforce composition by minority and female employees last year was directly related to poor business conditions and a strike, which caused us to lay off employees rather than hire.

Goal commitments for the coming year are based on good-faith efforts to place qualified minority and female employees in the workforce. Limiting factors, which could impact goal attainment, include continued lack of work.

- Employment and selection process.

We reaffirm our needs and commitment to equal employment opportunity with any agency or recruitment service we may use.

- Applicant flow

An analysis of the minority and female applicant flow at this facility reveals that minorities and females were aware that the company is an equal employment opportunity employer.

Jobs paying \$25,000 and less, for which we intend to recruit from the outside, are listed with the state job service (EDD).

- Total selection process

Applicant forms, referral efforts, job descriptions, job titles, interviews, test administration and validity and other selection procedures are monitored and evaluated to ensure compliance with our equal employment opportunity policy.

- Transfer and promotion practices

We monitor our employment policies and practices to make sure the lateral and vertical movement of minority and female employees does not occur at a lower rate than the corresponding rates for non-minority or male employees.

- Terminations

Affirmative action efforts are maintained to ensure that there is not a disproportionate ratio in the terminations of either minorities or women.

- Affected class analysis

IDENTIFICATION OF PROBLEM AREAS (continued)

An affected class review is made pursuant to CFR 60-2.1 and the results reveal that neither minorities nor females have been assigned to undesirable departments or jobs.

- While there have been limited training activities at this location, all employees, including minorities and women, are afforded equal opportunities to participate (depending on the particular training activity, need or subject) without discrimination relative to race, color, religion, national origin, age, sex, disability, veteran status or marital status.

- Desegregated facilities

All of our facilities have been, and are, fully non-segregated except for providing separate or single-user toilets and changing facilities to assure privacy between the sexes. All company-sponsored activities (picnics, parties, golf tournaments, etc.) are open to all employees.

- Transportation and housing

The availability of adequate transportation has not impeded the employment of minority of female workers to any significant degree. The Company does not maintain subsidized housing for its employees.

- Technical compliance

We are in compliance with all technical requirements such as poster display, application retention and subcontractor notification. We include the EEO clause on all purchase orders and subcontract agreements.

- Workforce attitude

Managers and employees relations representatives are available to assist in the resolution of problems. Management has been properly trained in the dynamics of Sexual Harassment/Hostile Environment issues. Management takes prompt action to prevent harassment and maintain a positive work environment. It is against Company policy for any person to use their official authority to make sexual advances toward employees over whom the person is authorized to make or recommend personnel actions, to grant, recommend or refuse to take personnel action as reprisal against any employee for rejecting or reporting sexual advances. It is also against Company policy for a manager or supervisor to allow any employee to be sexually harassed, either verbally or physically, by a co-worker.

IDENTIFICATION OF PROBLEM AREAS (continued)

Following are examples of sexual harassment:

- Displaying sexually suggestive picture, objects, cartoon or posters after being told they are offensive.
- Verbal harassment or abuse, referring to or calling a person an endearing, demanding or sexualized term when that person has indicated he/she does not wish to be addressed or referred to in that manner.
- Refusing to enforce disciplinary measures against a person who has been sexually harassing another staff member or otherwise condoning such behavior.
- Touching a person on a traditionally non-sexual part of the body, after that person has indicated no desire for such physical contact.
- Touching any traditionally sexual part of a co-worker's body – unnecessary touching, patting or pinching.
- Telling sexual jokes and using sexually vulgar language in the presence of a person whom has indicated dislike of such language or conversation.
- Subtle pressure activities. Continuing to write suggestive notes/letters after being informed they are unwelcome.
- Engaging in reprisal (making negative statements about the victim's personal or work conduct, assigning undesirable shifts, etc.) after an individual has refused to engage in social/sexual behavior.
- Sexual harassment of men as well as women is prohibited.

Any employee who believes he/she has been the subject of sexual harassment should report the alleged charge to the Equal Employment Opportunity Officer. At this time, the employee will be informed of the investigation procedure. Within three days of notification of the alleged charge, the Company EEO Officer will interview the complainant. At that time the complainant will be notified to submit a written complaint. Within three days of receiving the written complaint, the EEO Officer will apprise the alleged harasser of the charges. The alleged harasser will then have an opportunity to refute the allegation by submitting a written response. The EEO Officer will notify the alleged harasser's supervisor of the seriousness of the charge. If there is evidence to prove the allegation, they will discuss appropriate action up to and including discharge. If the details of the case are unclear or the evidence is insufficient for the Company to make a determination, for the Company to make a determination, the complainant may file an appeal by contacting the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission.

IDENTIFICATION OF PROBLEM AREAS (continued)

- Review of EEO performance

To enable Sully-Miller to meet federal EEO reporting requirements and to provide information to internal analysis, regular of EEO performance are made.

AFFIRMATIVE ACTION PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT AND EXECUTION

To facilitate achieving our affirmative action goals and timetables, Sully-Miller has initiated specific procedures and programs.

The program encompasses all major aspects of the employment process and is designed to correct either current procedural deficiencies or to intensify and accelerate the efficiency of present programs.

Recruiting efforts to fill open positions focus on consideration of minorities and women not currently in the workforce who have the requisite skills and can be recruited through affirmative action measures.

Job Posting

A job-posting program for non-executive positions is currently functioning at this facility. This program provides that all such job openings are posted on bulletin boards.

Educational Assistance Program

Our educational assistance program is available to all full time employees with the approval of their immediate supervisor. The plan covers partial reimbursement of tuition and books for job related courses.

Affirmative Action Training

Managers and supervisors are given regular; periodic equal employment opportunity training. This training demonstrates why EEO compliance is important and it gives participants instructions and tools to help them comply with EEO requirements. The EEO Officer regularly attends Superintendents meetings to discuss goals and to provide assistance in identifying qualified minorities and females to fill vacancies.

COMPLIANCE WITH SEX DISCRIMINATION GUIDELINES

In our efforts to comply with the federal Sex Discrimination Guidelines (41 CFR Part 60-20), Sully-Miller Contracting Company will follow these procedures and practices.

- Candidates from both sexes will be recruited for all jobs.
- Advertisements will not express a preference for applicants of a particular sex and are placed in a general "Help wanted" column.
- Written personnel policies will indicate that there will be no discrimination on the basis of a person's sex.
- Employees and applicants of both sexes shall have equal opportunities to be placed on any available job that they are qualified to perform.
- We will make no distinction based on a person's sex in employment opportunities, wages, hours of work, employee benefits or any other condition of employment.
- Mandatory or optional ages for retirement will be equal for both sexes.
- We will provide appropriate physical facilities for both sexes. Lack of facilities will not be used to deny applicants of either sex.
- Under the company's leave of absence policy, our granting of pregnancy leaves of absence for female employees depends on the individual's physical condition. When a female employee meets the equally applied minimum length of service requirement for leave of absence time, she is granted a leave in accord with the company's established leave of absence policy.
- Where seniority lists or line of progression are used, they will not be based on an employee's sex nor are they used to discriminate.
- Salaries and wage schedules will not be based on an employee's sex.
- As openings occur, Sully-Miller will take affirmative action to recruit and place women in those jobs that we have identified as under-utilized.
- Women have equal opportunity to participate in training programs sponsored by the Company, and we will make special efforts to include women in any management training programs that we offer.
- Sully-Miller recognizes its obligation to provide a work atmosphere free of harassment and intimidation. Any forms of sexual harassment, such as unwelcome sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, and/or other verbal or physical conduct of a sexual nature, will not be tolerated. Violations of this policy will be handled appropriately as part of the Company's disciplinary procedures and its posted policy in support of the Federal Guidelines on Sexual Harassment.

COMPLIANCE WITH RELIGION AND NATIONAL ORIGIN DISCRIMINATION GUIDELINES

Sully-Miller Contracting Company does not discriminate against employees or applicants because of religion or national origin, and take affirmative action to ensure that people are treated without regard to their religion or national origin.

Sully-Miller has reviewed its personnel actions and decisions – particularly on recruiting and promotion and has determined that members of various religions and/or ethnic groups are receiving fair consideration for job opportunities.

We make reasonable efforts to accommodate the religious observances and practices of our employees and prospective employees unless that person's religious observances or practices create undue hardship on the conduct of our business, resultant financial or personnel issues.

INTERNAL MONITORING AND REPORTING SYSTEM

As part of our affirmative action activities, to measure our program effectiveness and the implementation of affirmative action goals, we have developed an internal system for auditing and reporting.

The affirmative action monitoring and reporting system consists of data from:

- Applicant log (records of referral, applications and placement at all Levels)
- New hire log
- Promotion, Transfer, Demotion log

This information enables us to meet federal EEO reporting requirements through our affirmative action plan and provide the necessary information for internal analysis and monitoring.

These reports are reviewed to ensure implementation of remedial action when it is required. Reports are made to management on our performance against goals in affirmative action.

AREA AND COMMUNITY ACTION PROGRAMS

Sully-Miller Contracting Company engages in activities in support of equal employment opportunity in educational and community organizations and minority enterprises. The purpose of supporting these causes is to improve long-term employment opportunities for minorities and women.

We believe equal employment opportunity is an integral part of our responsibility for good corporate citizenship.

Our efforts include:

- Participating in job fairs and local colleges
- Lending support to minority and women owned businesses by participating in minority and women owned business enterprise conferences and awards functions.
- Encouraging employees to be involved in community organizations
- The EEO officer is a member of the Associated General Contractors Equal Employment Opportunity Committee, the Special Training Subcommittee and Emerging Contractors Committee.

SUPPORT OF MINORITY ENTERPRISE

Sully-Miller Contracting Company utilizes a number of minority enterprises as subcontractors. It is company policy not only to give them an opportunity to compete for our business but to seek them out so they may bid for business; and, when the Company has staff to do so and the Company believes that such subcontractors are qualified or capable of becoming qualified in their particular type of work will, (a) provide assistance to such a subcontractors with respect to procedures to be followed to obtain qualifications, as contractors or subcontractors on public projects, (b) provide assistance to such subcontractors in estimating and in the administration of the receipts and disbursement of the records. All subcontractors and subcontracts or purchase agreements in excess of \$10,000 must agree as part of its contractual obligation to have an equal employment opportunity policy and affirmative action plan acceptable to the Company or to abide by Sully-Miller's Equal Employment Opportunity Policy and Affirmative Action Plan. Subcontractors are notified of the requirement prior to signing the subcontract or purchase agreement. Should any subcontractor be out of compliance, we will take appropriate steps to assure compliance. We have been instrumental in assisting minority and women owned subcontractors to receive certification information. We advertise from time to time in nationally distributed minority publications which provide a resource for minority businesses.
