Yuba City has several parks that have non-potable wells. Some work would be required of the contractor to obtain water for construction. We also have potable water available from fire hydrants located throughout the City. However, if the conservation mandate from the State continues, we would be concerned about using potable water for construction, particularly if it is a large volume of water. Do you have an estimate of the volume of water required? Thank you.
