Yes, construction use is included in the metered service as long as you have an air gap on the water truck or you pull your water after the TESTED/CERTIFIED backflow preventer. Additionally during our phone conversation we discussed you providing the meter numbers and/or the service addresses to the meter in this project for inspection by the Water division.

We are completing a landscape and irrigation project on the Braided Ramps section of State Route 180 which will connect new irrigation equipment to existing water meters between State Routes 41 and 168. We have 6 existing water meters located within the project where we will connect our new system. I am requesting a "Will Serve" letter for this project that confirms the availability of water. The 6 water meters previously provided water to plant material that was removed for the construction of the new braided ramps, and this new project is installing less than 50% of the plant material previously serviced by the existing meters.
