Map Criteria

The map criteria provided below is from the California Department of Education School Facilities Planning Division (SFPD) document SFPD Advisory 00-05. While developed by the SFPD for EC 17215 evaluations, this same criteria should be used for EC 81033 and PUC 21655 evaluations.

Before the Division of Aeronautics Program will evaluate a proposed site, the following maps must be provided:

A dated vicinity map of architectural or cartographic quality (which is drawn to a scale of 1" = 1,000', 1" = 2,000', or 1" = 3,000' and can be measured by an engineer's scale shown in the legend) clearly depicting the proposed site's boundaries and the airport's runway(s);

A separate dated schematic that clearly depicts the layout and boundaries of the proposed facility (drawn to the same standards as the vicinity map with a recommended scale of 1" = 500') delineating all existing and proposed property boundaries and/or streets;

Maps containing multiple site locations should have individual names or numbers assigned to each individual proposed school site.
