A countywide transit map and a website will reflect the results of the coordination efforts and recommendations. | \$30,000 |
| 3 | El Dorado County Transportation Commission <i>El Dorado County Transit Authority</i> | El Dorado County Transit Authority Transit Ridership Survey | El Dorado | A consultant will develop and administer a survey to tabulate and analyze data, then compile a detailed written report that includes recommendations for service improvements. | \$17,000 |
| 4 | Metropolitan Transportation Commission <i>Marin County Transit District</i> | Tiburon Transit Needs Assessment | Marin | This assessment evaluates the existing transit services, identifies additional public transportation needs, and recommends service changes to Marin County Transit District. An implementation plan will then be developed on the basis of economic feasibility, improved service efficiencies, and better regional transit connections. | \$50,000 |
| 5 | Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments <i>Santa Cruz Metropolitan Transit District</i> | Santa Cruz Metropolitan Transit District Watsonville Transit Planning Study | Santa Cruz | This study will conduct surveys, then outline recommendations for improved transit service within the city and surrounding rural areas of Watsonville, California. | \$100,000 |
