2018 CSRP – Overview of Scope

- **PRIIA** (Passenger Rail Investment and Improvement Act)
 - Short and long-term Rail Investment Program
 - Analysis of “Program Effects”
- **AB 528**: state-specific requirements
 - 10-year intercity rail capital program
- **Network Integration Strategic Service Plan**
- **Establishes vision for statewide rail network**



2018 CSRP – Freight Plan Integration

- A statewide vision for freight rail to be completed **by July 2016**
- Characterize **freight corridors**
- Development of a **freight-specific capital program** to meet FRA requirements
- A **unified rail vision**, including passenger and freight



2018 CSRP – Coordination With Other Plans

- California Transportation Plan 2040
- California Sustainable Freight Action Plan
- California Freight Mobility Plan – FAST Compliance
 - Provide input to necessary updates
 - Identify priority investments for funding programs
